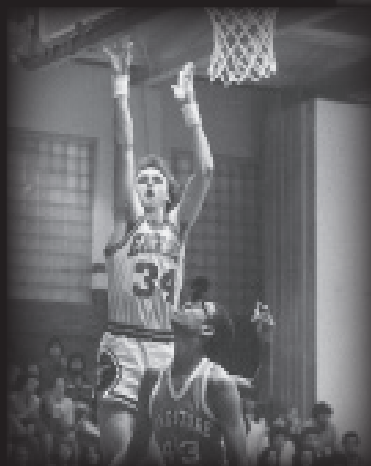

PAT KELSEY has led the Eagles to the Big South championship game in four of his eight seasons. During his eight years guiding the program has set numerous offensive records. In 2019-20 Kelsey moved into 2nd all-time for wins in program history and 5th in league history.

GREGG MARSHALL captured seven Big South Championships and made seven NCAA Tournament appearances in nine seasons with the Eagles. Marshall was inducted into the Winthrop Hall of Fame this past spring. During his tenure the team had six 20-win seasons and led the Eagles to their only NCAA Tournament victory in 2007 over Notre Dame, 74-64.
