#### TIP-INS

- First place in the Big South Conference South Division is on the line as the Eagles and Spartans sit at 5-1 in league play
- This is the 24th meeting between the Eagles and **Spartans**
- Eagles have won 10 straight in the series
- Six of the last eight meetings have come at the H.B. Hodge Center
- Winthrop is coming off its first league loss at High Point Monday night, which ended a Big South road win streak at 14 straight
- Over the last three seasons the Eagles are 23-2 in January
- Eagles picked up program's first victory over a PAC-12 opponent after win at Washington to end their losing streak at three games
- Eagles shooting for a third straight Big South Championship
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past five seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21)
- Posted the best record in the history of the program for winning percentage last season (.920 previous mark is .818 set by the 2006-07 team)

### EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

#### WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS USC UPSTATE

- The Eagles and Spartans meet for the 24th time as the Eagles have won 10 straight meetings and now lead the series 15-8
- This will be the fourth straight meeting at the G.B. Hodge Center in the series
- Eagles have won six straight on the road in the series
- When the two teams met in 2020 for a two-game series in back-to-back days the Eagles hit 29 threes (29-of-64)
- Eagles have hit 13 or more threes in three consecutive meetings
- In the last three meetings, Winthrop has hit the century mark twice (102.7 ppg) and are averging 15.0 made threes
- In 23 meetings all-time, the Eagles have scored 1,715 points (74.5 ppg) and Spartans have scored 1,618 points (70.3 ppg)

#### ON THIS DATE (Jan. 26)

- Eagles are 7-4 all-time (1-4 on road), 6-2 in Big South (2-2 on road)
- Of the 11 games played on this date, five of them have been two point games and six of them have been decided by two or fewer points
- In 2017 the Eagles had a 19-point lead early in the second half and hung on for a 72-70 win over Gardner-Webb as Xavier Cooks had 19 points, nine rebounds, three assists and two steals
- Cooks made two free throws with 14 seconds left for the 72-70 win as Duby Okeke blocked the game-tying field goal attempt for the win
- In 2013 the Eagles fel 58-57 at Radford as R.J. Price scored on a layup with 52 seconds left
- In 2012 the Eagles overcame a first half eight point deficit to hold on for a 65-63 win over Liberty as Reggie Middleton led the way with 20 points, six assists
- It was Joab Jerome that hit the game-winner with a jumper with 1:24 to play
- In 2002 Greg Lewis (20 points, 13 rebounds) and Marcus Stewart (12 points, 11 rebounds) each posted double-doubles to lead Winthrop to a 73-66 win at **UNCA**

#### ON THE ROAD IN BIG SOUTH

- Sitting at 2-1 on the road in the Big South after the loss at High Point, ending a conference road win streak at 14 straight Eagles have now won 20 of the last 22 road games in league play
- In the last eight league road games the Eagles are holding opponents to 61.8 ppg

- In the last eight league told gaines the Eagles are holding opponents to 01.0 ppg
  In that same span the Eagles have averaged 68.7 ppg
  In three road games the Eagles are averaging 62.0 ppg and allowing 62.7 ppg
  Winthrop is shooting 47 percent from the floor and 77 percent at the free throw line
  Committing 19.3 turnovers per game and has allowed 42 offensive rebounds in three games (14.0 per game)
  Posted a perfect 10.0 mark on the road in 2020 21 and have wen 10 of the least 20 games on the road in confe
- Posted a perfect 10-0 mark on the road in 2020-21 and have won 19 of the last 20 games on the road in conference play Averaged 79.7 ppg while allowing 66.7 ppg in the 10 road games while hitting 9.9 threes per game
- In league road games last year the Eagles had a +13.0 scoring margin and +11.7 rebound margin Have gone eight straight seasons with a .500 or better record on the road in league play Eagles have an all-time record of 137-136 in league road games

#### EAGLES ON THE ROAD

- Hold a 3-6 record this season after the loss at High Point
- Eagles in the midst of five out of six road games for the Eagles (three of the five in that stretch will be against opponents in South Carolina)
- Over the last five seasons the Eagles are 49-31 on the road
- Eagles have won 10 road games in each of the last two seasons and three of the last five seasons
- Have an all-time road mark of 251-354 and 200-302 at the NCAA D1 level
- Prior to the home game against Hartford, the Eagles went on a four-game road trip that covered over 7,300 miles (in a span of 12 days)

#### EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH

- Coming off a loss at High Point as the Eagles scored a season-low 56 points
- Eagles have failed to reach 70 points in three straight league games for the first time since 2014
- Winthrop's first five league games were decided by two possessions or less
- After holding High Point to 65 points, the Eagles have now held league opponents to 70 or fewer points in eight of the last 10 regular season games that ended in regulation (no overtime games included)
- In fact the Eagles haven't allowed over 70 points in 15 of the last 19 gamess that ended in regulation
- If you include all games against league opponents 18 of the last 23 games (70 or less)
- The 60 points in the win over Presbyterian was the first time this season the Eagles won a game scoring less than 70 points
- It was the lowest point total in a Winthrop win since Feb. 12, 2021 in a 55-47 win at Radford
- Trailed Gardner-Webb at the half and have won five straight league games when trailing at the half
- Lead the league in field goal percentage (.479) while the Eagles rank second in threes per game (8.5)
- Eagles defeated UNC Asheville in overtime and have now won four straight overtime games against league competition
- After defeating Campbell on Jan. 10, the Eagles have now won nine straight league openers
- Coming off back-to-back championships after claiming a league-best 13th Big South Title and looking to repeat as champions for the 8th time in program history
- Recorded a program record 17 conference wins in 2020-21 while the last two seasons the Eagles have started league play 13-0 (2020-21) and 12-0 (2019-20)
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 323-223 (.592)
- The 323 victories are the most by any Big South member
- Eagles are closing in on their 550th regular season Big South contest (545 currently)
- Have led the league in scoring offense the last five seasons
- Over the last three seasons the Eagles are 36-5 in league play
- Have gone eight straight seasons with a winning record during league play and 19 of the last 23 seasons

- This will be the fifth game of a stretch the Eagles play five out of six games on the road
- This will also be the Eagles fourth game in seven days (away-home-away-away)
- Six-game win streak came to an end at High Point
- Have won 13 of the last 16 meetings with programs from the state of North Carolina, 15-of-17 against league opponents (conference tourney included)
- Eagles have won 18 of the last 19 meetings with programs from the state of South Carolina
- Over the first six league games for the Eagles there have been a combined 43 ties and 42 lead changes
- Eagles are 12-7 for the 6th time in program history
- A win will make the Eagles 13-7 for the 7th time in program history and a loss will make them 12-8 for the 4th time
- Over the last three seasons the Eagles hold a record of 23-2 in the month of January and 49-110 in the last seven seasons
- Have an all-time record of 242-177 (.578) in the month of January
- The win over Washington on Nov. 27 was the program's 11th win over a Power 5 opponent and the first ever against a PAC-12 opponent
- Eagles connected on 16 threes at Washington State, the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Scored 58 points in the second half at Washington State, the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan.
- In the loss at Vanderbilt, the Eagles only attempted seven free throws (had gone 31 straight games with at least 10 or more attempts in a game)
- Winthrop fell at Middle Tennessee despite leading at the half, as the Eagles had won the previous 34 games in which it led at the break

### EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailed by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 267-253
- Through 19 games the Eagles have averaged 28.2 ppg from their bench (ranked 36th nationally as of Jan. 25)
- Eagles had less than 10 points from their bench for the first time this season in the win at PC (8)
- The bench matched its eight point contribution in the win over Gardner-Webb and while on the season the bench average is 28.2 the bench is only averaging just 18.7 ppg in league play For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
  Through 19 games this year the Eagles have 19 double-figure contributions off the bench
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 44-4 when leading at the half (102-13 since the start of the 2015-16 season/116-22 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 145-22 when leading at the half, 40-77 when trailing and 12-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 99-15 when leading at the half, 26-34 when trailing and 7-3 when tied (Last 9 seasons)
- In the last 156 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 98 of them (64%) (last double-digit victory over D1 opponent was the 80-53 win over Campbell in the 2021 Big South Title game
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 126-40 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 33-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 72-62 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 55-8 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

#### TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- The 12 straight road wins set a school record (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won 11 straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 304 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.4 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- 27 straight games with 10 or more assists

#### MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- He is the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 54-83 (47-59 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

- Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Winthrop finished 5th in the 2020-21 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage
- Led the Big South in scoring for a 5th straight season
- Featured one of the premier rebounding teams in the country, finishing 9th in rebound margin (+8.7), 10th in rebounds per game and 14th in offensive rebounds (12.96)
- Finished second in the nation in bench points (36.0 ppg)
- Tied for first nationally in true road wins (10)

# MARK PROSSER

Rock Hill, S.C. – Winthrop University Mark Prosser has been hired as the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history, announced Friday by the Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Ken Halpin.

Prosser has spent the last three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first

round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of threetime first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP. A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.






