TIP-INS

- Looking to end a three-game skid as the Eagles haven't dropped three straight since December of 2019
- Had a 12-game win streak on the road snapped at Middle Tennessee
- For the first time since 2012-13 the Eagles are led by a new head coach as Mark Prosser begins his tenure at the helm of the Winthrop program
- Eagles coming off their 11th NCAA Appearance and back-to-back Big South Conference Titles
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past five seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21)
- Posted the best record in the history of the program for winning percentage last season (.920 - previous mark is .818 set by the 2006-07 team)
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Winthrop finished 5th in the 2020-21 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Moved into the CI Top 25 on at 23rd this season but during the losing streak dropped out and received 19 votes in the most recent poll

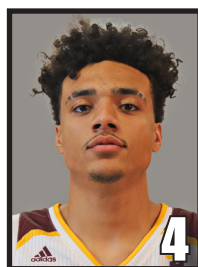

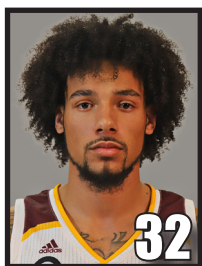

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP VERSUS WASHINGTON AND THE PAC 10/12

- This marks the first ever meeting between the Eagles and Huskies
- Winthrop's first ever meeting against a PAC 10/12 foe was Nov. 11, 2000 in Chapel Hill, N.C. as part of the Pizza Hut NABC Classic as it faced Arizona State (Lost, 76-68)
- Eagles are 0-5 all-time against PAC 10/12 opponents, with three of those meetings coming on a neutral court and two of them in the NCAA Tournament

ON THIS DATE (Nov. 27)

- Eagles are 10-4 all-time and 2-3 on the road
- In 2006 Michael Jenkins had 14 points, 9 assists and 3 steals to lead the Eagles to a 90-46 win over Virginia Intermont
- Phillip Williams record a double-double of 20 points and 10 rebounds in the win
- In 2004 the Eagles opened their home schedule with a 60-49 win over Weber State as Torrell Martin led the team with 13 points and James Shuler added 12 (that win was the first of a five-game win streak)
- In 2002, Tyrone Walker hit a jumper with 8.5 seconds remaining to earn a 68-66 win at Gardner-Webb
- The Eagles trailed by as much as seven points in the second half and four points with 2:39 left
- Walker finished the game with 20 points, 8 rebounds, 3 assists and 2 steals

EAGLES ON THE ROAD

- Had the nation's current top active win streak on the road with 12 in a row until the loss at Middle Tennessee
- Looking to avoid a fourth straight road loss, which hasn't happened since December of 2019 (Lost at ETSU, at Duke, at TCU, at Furman)
- Have an all-time road mark of 249-351 and 198-299 at the NCAA D1 level
- Eagles have won 10 road games in each of the last two seasons and at least 10 in three of the last five seasons
- Over the last five seasons the Eagles have a 46-28 road record
- This game is the final contest of a four game road trip, with the first two being played in Tennessee and the final two played in the state of Washington
- The current road trip will cover over 7,300 miles

TEAM NEWS

- Have dropped three straight and are 2-3 for the 9th time in program history
- Coming off a six point loss at Washington State in which the Eagles connected on 16 threes, the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Winthrop leads the Big South and is tied for 7th nationally (games thru 11/25) in threes per game (12.4)
- The 58 points in the second half were the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan. 16, 2020
- Through 5 games the Eagles have 62 total threes, which are tied for the 31st most in the nation (games through 11/25/21)
- Among teams with only five games played, only The Citadel, Furman, and Oral Roberts have more
- In the loss at Vanderbilt, the Eagles only attempted seven free throws (had gone 31 straight games with at least 10 or more attempts in a game)
- Winthrop fell at Middle Tennessee despite leading at the half, as the Eagles had won the previous 34 games in which it led at the break
- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailed by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- The win was the fifth straight for the Eagles at home
- Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team
- Mark Prosser is the 7th head coach in program history and he became the 7th to win in their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 261-249
- Through five games the Eagles have averaged 42.0 ppg from their bench
- For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Through five games this year the Eagles have nine double-figure contributions off the bench

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 38-2 when leading at the half (96-11 since the start of the 2015-16 season/110-20 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 139-20 when leading at the half, 38-74 when trailing and 10-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 98-14 when leading at the half, 24-34 when trailing and 5-3 when tied
- In the last 146 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 96 of them (66%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 121-37 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 33-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 67-61 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 53-8 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Have lost three straight for the first time since 2019 (Also the last time the Eagles lost four straight)
- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- The 12 straight road wins set a school record (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won five straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 290 consecutive games
- Had a streak of 85 straight games making five or more three-point baskets come to an end in the opening game of the Longwood series
- 13 straight games with 11 or more assists

MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach - 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 44-79 (39-56 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduated from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage
- Led the Big South in scoring for a 5th straight season
- Featured one of the premier rebounding teams in the country, finishing 9th in rebound margin (+8.7), 10th in rebounds per game and 14th in offensive rebounds (12.96)
- Finished second in the nation in bench points (36.0 ppg)
- Tied for first nationally in true road wins
