WINTHROP

TIP-INS

- This is the first ever meeting between Winthrop and Carver as the Eagles look for a 56th straight win against a Non-D1 opponent
- In the last four season the Eagles are 15-5 in the month of December
- Eagles picked up program's first victory over a PAC-12 opponent after win at Washington to end their losing streak at three games
- For the first time since 2012-13 the Eagles are led by a new head coach as Mark Prosser begins his tenure at the helm of the Winthrop program
- Eagles coming off their 11th NCAA Appearance and back-to-back Big South Conference Titles
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past five seasons (2016-17) 2019-20 / 2020-21)
- Posted the best record in the history of the program for winning percentage last season (.920 previous mark is .818 set by the 2006-07 team)
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Winthrop finished 5th in the 2020-21 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- The Eagles have been as high as 23rd in the Mid-Major poll this season and have received votes every week



EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP VERSUS CARVER AND NON-D1 OPPONENTS

- This is the first ever meeting with Carver College
- Eagles have won 55 straight games against Non-D1 programs and 98-8 all-time
- Winthrop defeated Mary Baldwin 110-78 in the season opener
- It was the 23rd time the Eagles posted 100 or more points against a non-D1 opponent (Have hit the century mark in 12 of the last 13 games vs. Non-D1 teams)

ON THIS DATE (Dec. 11)

- This marks just the 5th game all-time the Eagles have played on Dec. 11 with a 4-1 record on this day
- The last time the Eagles played on Dec. 11 was 2019 in Fort Worth, Texas at TCU in a 70-60 loss
- Winthrop has never scored more than 79 points on this date (2011 vs. UVA Wise in a 79-70 win)

EAGLES ON A NEUTRAL COURT

- Winthrop has an all-time mark of 47-51 on a neutral court
- Eagles are 37-43 since becoming an NCAA D1 member, have a 10-19 record in regular season games, 26-13 in Big South Conference Tournament games and 1-11 in the NCAA Tournament
- The last time the Eagles played a neutral site contest during the regular season was early December of 2020
- Winthrop took on UNC Greensboro and Little Rock during a multi-team event played at the KFC Yum! Center in Louis-ville, Ky.
- The Eagles earned wins over UNCG and Little Rock

TEAM NEWS

- Coming off a win and sitting at 5-4 for the 11th time in program history
- A win would make the Eagles 6-4 for the 7th time and a loss will make them 5-5 for the 14th time
- Eagles have scored 100 or more points in the last 10 meetings with Non-D1 opponents (last time below 100 was 2016 vs. Ferrum in a 66-47 win)
- Have an all-time record of 127-138 (.479) in the month of December and have won 11 of the last 12 contests
- Since 2018-19 the Eagles are 15-5 in the month of December
- Ended losing streak at three games after 82-74 victory at Washington
- The win over Washington was the first in program history over a PAC-12 opponent
- The win is the 11th win over a Power 5 program all-time
- Eagles connected on 16 threes at Washington State, the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Eagles are 1-of-4 programs this season to hit 16 or more threes against a Power 5 opponent
- Eagles are leading the Big South in scoring (80.6 ppg) and threes per game (10.2)
- Rank 25th nationally in threes per game and 45th in scoring offense
- Scored 58 points in the second half at Washington State, the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan. 16, 2020
- In the loss at Vanderbilt, the Eagles only attempted seven free throws (had gone 31 straight games with at least 10 or more attempts in a game)
- Winthrop fell at Middle Tennessee despite leading at the half, as the Eagles had won the previous 34 games in which it led at the break
- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailed by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- The win was the fifth straight for the Eagles at home
- Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 262-251
- Through eight games the Eagles have averaged 32.4 ppg from their bench (ranked 22nd nationally)
- For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Through nine games this year the Eagles have 11 double-figure contributions off the bench (one in the last three games)
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 41-2 when leading at the half (99-11 since the start of the 2015-16 season/113-20 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 142-20 when leading at the half, 38-75 when trailing and 10-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 98-14 when leading at the half, 24-34 when trailing and 5-3 when tied

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- In the last 149 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 96 of them (65%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 123-38 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 33-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 68-61 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 54-8 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- The 12 straight road wins set a school record (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won seven straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 294 consecutive games
- Had a streak of 85 straight games making five or more three-point baskets come to an end in the opening game of the Longwood series
- 17 straight games with 10 or more assists

MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- He is the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 47-80 (42-56 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- · After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage
- Led the Big South in scoring for a 5th straight season
- Featured one of the premier rebounding teams in the country, finishing 9th in rebound margin (+8.7), 10th in rebounds per game and 14th in offensive rebounds (12.96)
- Finished second in the nation in bench points (36.0 ppg)
- Tied for first nationally in true road wins
