WINTHROP

TIP-INS

- Eagles coming off first victory over a PAC-12 opponent after win at Washington to end their losing streak at three games
- Coming off a road trip that covered over 7,300 miles and a 1-3 record
- For the first time since 2012-13 the Eagles are led by a new head coach as Mark Prosser begins his tenure at the helm of the Winthrop program
- Eagles coming off their 11th NCAA Appearance and back-to-back Big South Conference Titles
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past five seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21)
- Posted the best record in the history of the program for winning percentage last season (.920 - previous mark is .818 set by the 2006-07 team)
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Winthrop finished 5th in the 2020-21 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Moved into the CI Top 25 on at 23rd this season but during the losing streak dropped out and received 17 votes in the most recent poll

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP VERSUS HARTFORD AND THE AMERICA EAST

- This is the third meeting all-time between Winthrop and Hartford
- The all-time series is tied 1-1 as the Eagles won the last meeting 67-57 in the 2019-20 season opener (11/7/19)
- Six current Eagles played in that game as Chase Claxton, Micheal Anumba and Russell Jones Jr. each started
- Eagles are 1-2 all-time against opponents from the America East Conference
- Outside of the two matchups with Hartford, the Eagles hosted New Hampshire in 2016 and fell 65-60

ON THIS DATE (Dec. 1)

- Hold a 6-6 mark all-time, 3-1 at home and 4-4 since moving to the NCAA D1 level
- Eagles opened the 2020-21 season on Dec. against UNC Greensboro in Louisville, Ky. as they earned a 75-67 win behind 14 points from Chandler Vaudrin and Adonis Arms (That win triggered a 16 game winning streak)
- In 2014, sophomore Jarad Scott scored a career-high 15 points and the Eagles hit nine threes in a 68-47 win over Savannah State
- In 2011 Andre Jones scored a game-high 24 points to lead Winthrop to a 59-56 win at Presbyterian College in the Big South Conference opener

EAGLES AT HOME

- Eagles are 446-168 all-time in home games and 399-156 all-time in the Winthrop Coliseum
- Currently riding a five-game home win streak and have won 16 of the last 17
- Since 1998-99 the Eagles are 267-60 at home (.816 winning percentage)
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles are 109-25 at home (.813 winning percentage)
- Since joining the NCAA D1 level, the Eagles are 368-139 in home games
- Have won at least 11 home games in nine straight seasons and were 11-1 in 2020-21
- Averaged 79.8 ppg while allowing 66.2 ppg at home in 2020-21
- Outrebounded opponents 40.5 31.0 in 12 home games last season

TEAM NEWS

- Ended losing streak at three games after 82-74 victory at Washington
- The win over Washington was the first in program history over a PAC-12 opponent
- The win is the 11th win over a Power 5 program all-time
- 3-3 for the 13th time in program history
- Eagles connected on 16 threes at Washington State, the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Winthrop leads the Big South and 12th nationally (games thru 11/30) in threes per game (11.3)
- Scored 58 points in the second half at Washington State, the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan. 16, 2020
- In the loss at Vanderbilt, the Eagles only attempted seven free throws (had gone 31 straight games with at least 10 or more attempts in a game)
- Winthrop fell at Middle Tennessee despite leading at the half, as the Eagles had won the previous 34 games in which it led at the break
- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailed by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- The win was the fifth straight for the Eagles at home
- Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 262-250
- Through six games the Eagles have averaged 38.0 ppg from their bench (ranked third nationally)
- For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Through six games this year the Eagles have 10 double-figure contributions off the bench
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 39-2 when leading at the half (97-11 since the start of the 2015-16 season/111-20 since the 2014-15 season)

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 140-20 when leading at the half, 38-74 when trailing and 10-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 98-14 when leading at the half, 24-34 when trailing and 5-3 when tied
- In the last 147 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 96 of them (65%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 122-37 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 33-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 67-61 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 53-8 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- The 12 straight road wins set a school record (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won five straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 291 consecutive games
- Had a streak of 85 straight games making five or more three-point baskets come to an end in the opening game of the Longwood series
- 14 straight games with 11 or more assists

MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- He is the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 45-79 (40-56 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA
 Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage
- Led the Big South in scoring for a 5th straight season
- Featured one of the premier rebounding teams in the country, finishing 9th in rebound margin (+8.7), 10th in rebounds per game and 14th in offensive rebounds (12.96)
- Finished second in the nation in bench points (36.0 ppg)
- Tied for first nationally in true road wins
