- Since 2018-19 the Eagles are 16-6 in the month of December For the first time since 2012-13 the Eagles are led by a new head coach as Mark Prosser begins his tenure at the helm of the Winthrop program
- Eagles coming off their 11th NCAA Appearance and back-to-back Big South Conference Titles
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past five seasons (2016-17) 2019-20 / 2020-21)
- Posted the best record in the history of the program for winning percentage last season (.920 previous mark is .818 set by the 2006-07 team)
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Winthrop finished 5th in the 2020-21 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- The Eagles have been as high as 23rd in the Mid-Major poll this season

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP VERSUS MISSISSIPPI STATE AND THE SEC

- This is just the second meeting all-time between Winthrop and Mississippi State
- The Eagles won the only meeting 74-63 at Humphrey Coliseum on Nov. 18, 2006 during the Eagles historic season
- This marks the 33rd meeting with an opponent from the Southeastern Conference
- Winthrop is 0-1 against SEC opponents this season, having lost 77-63 at Vanderbilt on Nov. 20
- Eagles are 3-29 all-time against teams from the SEC with all three wins coming on the road

ON THIS DATE (Dec. 21)

- Eagles are 8-6 all-time on this day with a 3-3 mark in road games (This marks first ever neutral site game on Dec. 21)
- In 2017, Xavier Cooks recorded a triple-double with 11 points, 15 rebounds and 11 assists to lead Winthrop to a 107-76 rout of Reinhardt University
- In 2007 the Eagles held off Old Dominion for a 62-59 home win behind a balanced offense with four players in double-figures
- In 2006 the Eagles blew out East Carolina on the road, 70-48, behind five threes and 19 points from Michael Jenkins
- In 2002 the Eagles earned a hard fought 84-73 win at Eastern Kentucky behind 27 points from Pierre Wooten and a double-double from Marcus Cooke (12 points, 14 rebounds)

EAGLES ON A NEUTRAL COURT

- Winthrop has an all-time mark of 48-51 on a neutral court
- Eagles are 38-43 since becoming an NCAA D1 member, have a 11-19 record in regular season games, 26-13 in Big South Conference Tournament games and 1-11 in the NCAA Tournament
- This is the second neutral site game of the season for the Eagles, who took on Carver College at the Rock Hill Sports & Event Center
- Eagles return to the Mississippi Coliseum where they suffered a 76-71 loss to Ole Miss on Dec. 13, 2007

TEAM NEWS

- Coming off a loss at Elon and sitting at 6-5 for the 13th time in program history
- Winthrop scored a season-low 61 points in the loss at Elon and it's the fewest points allowed in a loss on the road since falling 61-58 at ETSU on Nov. 14, 2019
- Winthrop's offense has now been held under 70 points in 4-of-7 games played away from the Winthrop Coliseum
- Eagles led by 12 points at Elon, their first loss holding a double-digit lead since Feb. 21, 2019 at Radford in an 87-81 loss
- A win would make the Eagles 7-5 for the 10th time and a loss will make them 6-6 for the 8th time
- In the only other meeting with Mississippi State (11-18-06) the Eagles were 26-of-30 from the foul line and led by a Phillip Williams double-double of 22 points, 11 rebounds
- Have an all-time record of 128-139 (.479) in the month of December and have won 12 of the last 14 contests
- Since 2018-19 the Eagles are 16-6 in the month of December
- The win over Washington on Nov. 27 was the program's 11th win over a Power 5 opponent and the first ever against a PAC-12 opponent
- Eagles connected on 16 threes at Washington State, the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Eagles are 1-of-6 programs this season to hit 16 or more threes against a Power 5 opponent
- Eagles second in the Big South in scoring (79.0 ppg) and first in threes per game (9.9 first time this season averaging less than 10)
- The 9.9 threes per game are tied for 27th nationally
- Scored 58 points in the second half at Washington State, the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan. 16, 2020
- In the loss at Vanderbilt, the Eagles only attempted seven free throws (had gone 31 straight games with at least 10 or more attempts in a game)
- Winthrop fell at Middle Tennessee despite leading at the half, as the Eagles had won the previous 34 games in which it led at the break
- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailed by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 263-251
- Through 11 games the Eagles have averaged 34.5 ppg from their bench (ranked 17th nationally as of Dec. 20)
- For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Through 11 games this year the Eagles have 13 double-figure contributions off the bench
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 42-3 when leading at the half (100-12 since the start of the 2015-16 season/114-21 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 143-21 when leading at the half, 38-75 when trailing and 10-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 98-14 when leading at the half, 24-34 when trailing and 5-3 when tied
- In the last 150 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 97 of them (65%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 124-39 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 33-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 68-61 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 55-8 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- The 12 straight road wins set a school record (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won seven straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 296 consecutive games
- Six straight season averaging 8.4 three-pointers per game as a team
- Had a streak of 85 straight games making five or more three-point baskets come to an end in the opening game of the Longwood series
- 19 straight games with 10 or more assists

MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- He is the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 48-81 (43-57 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA
 Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage
- Led the Big South in scoring for a 5th straight season
- Featured one of the premier rebounding teams in the country, finishing 9th in rebound margin (+8.7), 10th in rebounds per game and 14th in offensive rebounds (12.96)
- Finished second in the nation in bench points (36.0 ppg)
- Tied for first nationally in true road wins (10)

MARK PROSSER

Rock Hill, S.C. – Winthrop University Mark Prosser has been hired as the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history, announced Friday by the Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Ken Halpin.

Prosser has spent the last three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of threetime first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP. A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.
