

- Over the last two seasons the Eagles are 19-1 in January
- Eagles picked up program's first victory over a PAC-12 opponent after win at Washington to end their losing streak at three games
- Eagles shooting for a third straight Big South Championship
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past five seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21)
- Posted the best record in the history of the program for winning percentage last season (.920 previous mark is .818 set by the 2006-07 team)

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS UNC ASHEVILLE

- This marks the 83rd meeting all-time between the Eagles and Bulldogs
- The Bulldogs won the last meeting, 57-55, in Rock Hill on Jan. 29, 2021 but Winthrop leads the all-time series 45-37
- Eagles have won 10 of the last 11 meetings against the Bulldogs at home
- In 82 meetings all-time, Winthrop has scored 5,960 points (72.7 ppg) and Asheville has scored 5,702 points (69.5 ppg)
- In 82 meetings there have been seven games decided by one point and 22 games decided by five or fewer points
- Winthrop has more 100 point games (4) against UNC Asheville than against any other opponent and has allowed 100 or more points to the Bulldogs three
 times

ON THIS DATE (Jan. 13)

- Eagles are 9-3 all-time on this date, 3-1 at home and 4-1 in Big South games
- In 1983, Tom TenBroeck scored a team-high 14 points to lead the Eagles to a 48-47 win at Lander, the 100th in program history
- In 2007 the Eagles recorded one of their biggest margin of victories in a road league game with a 68-40 win at Liberty behind 16 points from Craig Bradshaw and 15 points from Micheal Jenkins

EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH

- Looking to start league play 2-0 for a 4th straight season
- Lead the league in field goal percentage (.475) and three-point field goal percentage (.378)
- Rank 2nd in the league in scoring (77.4 ppg), assists per game (14.7) and three-point field goals per game (9.6)
- After defeating Campbell on Jan. 10, the Eagles have now won nine straight league openers
- · Coming off back-to-back championships after claiming a league-best 13th Big South Title
- Looking to repeat as champions for the 8th time in program history
- Recorded a program record 17 conference wins in 2020-21
- The last two seasons the Eagles have started league play 13-0 (2020-21) and 12-0 (2019-20)
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 319-222 (.589)
- The 319 victories are the most by any Big South member
- Have led the league in scoring offense the last five seasons
- Over the last three seasons the Eagles are 33-4 in league play
- Have gone eight straight seasons with a winning record during league play and 19 of the last 23 seasons

AT HOME IN BIG SOUTH

- · Eagles have now won five straight league home openers after the win over Campbell on Monday
- The last home loss in league play came against UNC Asheville on Jan. 29, 2021 in a 57-55 defeat
- · Eagles were 7-1 at home last season with a series sweeps of Campbell, Gardner-Webb and Longwood
- Held opponents to 65 or fewer points in half of last year's home league games
- Averaged 78.4 ppg while allowing 69.4 ppg last season
- All-time the Eagles hold a Big South regular season record of 184-86 (68%)
- Haven't lost more than two home league games since 2011-12

EAGLES AT HOME

- Eagles are 450-168 all-time in home games and 403-156 all-time in the Winthrop Coliseum
- Currently riding a nine-game home win streak and have won 20 of the last 21
- Looking for a 7-0 start in home games for a second straight season
- In six home games this season the Eagles are averaging 86.2 ppg while allowing 71.7 ppg
- Averaging 11.2 threes per game while allowing 10.9 per game
- Since 1998-99 the Eagles are 272-60 at home (.819 winning percentage)
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles are 113-25 at home (.818 winning percentage)
- Since joining the NCAA D1 level, the Eagles are 372-139 in home games
- Have won at least 11 home games in nine straight seasons and were 11-1 in 2020-21
- Averaged 79.8 ppg while allowing 66.2 ppg at home in 2020-21
 Outrebounded opponents 40.5 31.0 in 12 home games last season

TEAM NEWS

- Coming off a 74-72 win over Campbell as the Eagles have now won nine straight Big South openers
- This will be the 15th time the Eagles have been selected to be a part of the Big South Conference ESPNU Wild Card and are 10-4 all-time
- Winthrop and Asheville meet for the 6th time as part of the ESPNU Wildcard as the Eagles hold a 3-2 edge head-to-head
- Eagles are 8-6 for the 7th time in program history
- A win will make the Eagles 9-6 for the 5th time in program history and a loss will make them 8-7 for the 5th time
- · Over the last two seasons the Eagles hold a record of 19-1 in the month of January and 45-10 in the last seven seasons
- Have an all-time record of 238-176 (.574) in the month of January
- The win over Washington on Nov. 27 was the program's 11th win over a Power 5 opponent and the first ever against a PAC-12 opponent
- · Eagles connected on 16 threes at Washington State, the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Scored 58 points in the second half at Washington State, the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan. 16, 2020
- · In the loss at Vanderbilt, the Eagles only attempted seven free throws (had gone 31 straight games with at least 10 or more attempts in a game)
- · Winthrop fell at Middle Tennessee despite leading at the half, as the Eagles had won the previous 34 games in which it led at the break
- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailed by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- · Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 266-253
- Through 14 games the Eagles have averaged 32.0 ppg from their bench (ranked 11th nationally as of Jan. 12)
- For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Through 14 games this year the Eagles have 16 double-figure contributions off the bench
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 43-3 when leading at the half (101-12 since the start of the 2015-16 season/115-21 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 144-21 when leading at the half, 38-77 when trailing and 11-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 98-14 when leading at the half, 24-34 when trailing and 6-3 when fied
- In the last 152 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 98 of them (65%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 124-40 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 33-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 70-61 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 55-8 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- The 12 straight road wins set a school record (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- · Have won nine straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 299 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.4 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- Had a streak of 85 straight games making five or more three-point baskets come to an end in the opening game of the Longwood series
- 22 straight games with 10 or more assists

MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- He is the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game (Dan Kenney/ Gregg Marshall)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 50-82 (43-58 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- · After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Winthrop finished 5th in the 2020-21 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- $\bullet \qquad \text{Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage} \\$
- Led the Big South in scoring for a 5th straight season
- Featured one of the premier rebounding teams in the country, finishing 9th in rebound margin (+8.7), 10th in rebounds per game and 14th in offensive rebounds (12.96)
- Finished second in the nation in bench points (36.0 ppg)
- Tied for first nationally in true road wins (10)

MARK PROSSER

Rock Hill, S.C. – Winthrop University Mark Prosser has been hired as the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history, announced Friday by the Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Ken Halpin.

Prosser has spent the last three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of threetime first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP. A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.






