- Eagles picked up program's first victory over a PAC-12 opponent after win at Washington
- Eagles shooting for a third straight Big South Championship
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past five seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21)

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS USC UPSTATE

- Winthrop and USC Upstate meet for the second time this season and 25th overall
- Eagles overcame an 11 point deficit with 8:20 to play in the game to win 95-91 in overtime
- Eagles have won 11 straight meetings and lead the all-time series 16-8
- This is only the second time the Eagles have hosted Upstate since its move to the Big South (Jan. 23, 2020 Eagles won 79-53)
- Winthrop has hit 11 or more threes vs. Upstate in four straight meetings (56-for-118 in that span .474)
- In the last four meetings the Eagles are 55-for-94 at the foul line (.585)
- Winthrop has reached 90 or more points in five straight meetings, averaging 98.6 ppg in that span
- In 24 meetings all-time, the Eagles have scored 1,810 points (75.4 ppg) and Upstate has scored 1,709 points (71.2 ppg)

ON THIS DATE (Feb. 24)

- Eagles are 7-5 all-time (4-4 at home) and 5-4 vs. Big South opponents (3-3 at home)
- In 2011 the Eagles defeated Liberty 61-56 at home for the program's 200th Big South win
- In 2007 the Eagles won at Coastal Carolina for a 15th straight win behind a 32-point performance from Torrell Martin
- In 2001 the Eagles earned a 71-58 win at UNC Asheville to clinch the second seed for the conference tournament over Asheville

AT HOME IN BIG SOUTH

- Averaging 68.5 ppg while shooting just shy of 50 percent (.498) in league home games
- Have held opponents to an average of 62.8 ppg in all games and 56.3 ppg in the last four Held Radford to 48 points in the win on Feb. 9, the fewest points allowed in a league home game since Jan. 21, 2019 when they held Asheville to 45
- Off to a 6-0 start at home and have won 20 of the last 23 home contests
- The last time the Eagles were undefeated at home in league play was 2006-07
- In program history the Eagles have gone undefeated at home against league opponents five times (06-07, 04-05, 00-01, 99-00, 98-99)
- Eagles were 7-1 at home last season with a series sweeps of Campbell, Gardner-Webb and Longwood
- Held opponents to 65 or fewer points in half of last year's home league games
- Averaged 78.4 ppg while allowing 69.4 ppg last season
- All-time the Eagles hold a Big South regular season record of 189-86 (68%)
- Haven't lost more than two home league games since 2011-12

EAGLES AT HOME

- Averaging 77.6 ppg while holding opponents to 66.8 ppg
- Shooting 51 percent from the floor and 37 percent from three while holding opponets to 41 percent shooting and 34 percent behind the arc
- Outrebounding opponents 36.0 30.9 in home games
- Eagles are 455-168 all-time in home games and 408-156 all-time in the Winthrop Coliseum
- Currently riding an 14-game home win streak and have won 25 of the last 26
- Off to a 11-0 start in home games for a second straight season
- Trying to become the 3rd team to finish the season with an undfeated record at home (2006-07, 2004-05)
- It is the 10th straight season the Eagles reached 10 home wins in a season
- Since 1998-99 the Eagles are 277-60 at home (.816 winning percentage)
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles are 118-25 at home (.813 winning percentage)
- Since joining the NCAA D1 level, the Eagles are 376-139 in home games
- Have won at least 11 home games in nine straight seasons and were 11-1 in 2020-21
- Averaged 79.8 ppg while allowing 66.2 ppg at home in 2020-21
- Outrebounded opponents 40.5 31.0 in 12 home games last season

EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH

- Sitting two games above Gardner-Webb in the South Division standings and with a win will claim the South Division title outright
- Have won six straight league games, four of them by 10 or more points
- Coming off back-to-back road wins at Gardner-Webb and UNC Asheville
- In 14 league games for the Eagles there have been a combined 81 ties and 76 lead changes
- Since allowing 92 points to Longwood, the Eagles have held four of their last six opponents to 61 points or less (average of 61.5 ppg)
- Winthrop trailed Hampton by 11 points in the first half and came back to win by $\hat{10}$
- It was the fourth time this season the Eagles have trailed by double-figures against league opponents and came back to get the victory (at PC, vs. Gardner-Webb, at USC Upstate, at Hampton)
- Eagles are 12-2 in league play for just the second time in program history (2019-20) and third best Winthrop record for a 16-game league schedule
- It's just the third time the Eagles have won at least 12 games in a 16-game league slate
- The 2004-05 holds the best mark for 16-game league schedule at 15-1 and 2005-06 has the second-best at 13-3
- Trailing 38-27 at the half at Longwood, the Eagles posted a season-high 61 points in the second half in a comeback that fell just short in a 92-88 loss
- It was the most in a half against a league opponent since Jan. 5, 2019 at UNCA (61 in second half)
- In that same half the Eagles allowed 54 to Longwood, the first time since Dec. 30, 2020 the Eagles gave up 50 or more in a half
- It was the most allowed in a half against a league foe since allowing 53 in an 89-88 win at PC (2/15/20)
- Eagles had won nine straight regular season league games before the loss to High Point, the 6th longest streak in program history
- Winthrop had won 32 straight games against Big South opponents while leading at the half before its leading at the half in the loss at High Point
- Winthrop's first five league games were decided by two possessions or less and now 9-of-14
- On Feb. 9 the Eagles scored 58 in the win over Radford, which was the lowest point total in a Winthrop win since Feb. 12, 2021 in a 55-47 win at Radford After defeating Campbell on Jan. 10, the Eagles have now won nine straight league openers
- Coming off back-to-back championships after claiming a league-best 13th Big South Title and looking to repeat as champions for the 8th time in program history
- Recorded a program record 17 conference wins in 2020-21 while the last two seasons the Eagles have started league play 13-0 (2020-21) and 12-0 (2019-20)
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 330-224 (.594)
- The 330 victories are the most by any Big South member
- Eagles played in their 550th regular season Big South in the win at Hampton
- Have led the league in scoring offense the last five seasons (Currently 2nd in the Big South)
- Over the last three seasons the Eagles are 44-6 in league play
- Have gone eight straight seasons with a winning record during league play and 19 of the last 23 seasons

TEAM NEWS

- Eagles have won 20 of the last 21 meetings with programs from the state of South Carolina
- Have won 16 of the last 19 meetings with programs from the state of North Carolina, 18-of-20 against league opponents (conference tourney included)
- In the last 23 meetings with programs from the state of Virginia the Eagles are 18-5
- Eagles are 19-8 for the 3rd time in program history
- A win will make the Eagles 20-8 for the 5th time in program history and a loss will make them 19-9 for the 3rd time
- If the Eagles win it will be the 14th 20-win season in program history and the 3rd straight season with 20 or more
- Finished January with a loss at Longwood, but over the last three seasons the Eagles hold a record of 24-3 in the month and 50-12 in the last seven seasons
- Have an all-time record of 244-177 (.578) in the month of January

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Have opened February 6-0 and are 220-144 all-time in the month of February
- Over the last two seasons the Eagles are 17-3 in the month of February and 53-23 since 2012-13 (last 10 years) and have won 11 in a row
- The win over Washington on Nov. 27 was the program's 11th win over a Power 5 opponent and the first ever against a PAC-12 opponent
- Eagles connected on 16 threes at Washington State, the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Scored 58 points in the second half at Washington State, the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan. 16, 2020
- In the loss at Vanderbilt, the Eagles only attempted seven free throws (had gone 31 straight games with at least 10 or more attempts in a game)
- Winthrop fell at Middle Tennessee despite leading at the half, as the Eagles had won the previous 34 games in which
 it led at the break
- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailed by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 267-254
- Through 27 games the Eagles have averaged 29.6 ppg from their bench (ranked 10th nationally as of Feb. 21)
- Eagles had less than 10 points from their bench for the first time this season in the win at PC (8)
- . For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Through 27 games this year the Eagles have 29 double-figure contributions off the bench
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 48-4 when leading at the half (106-13 since the start of the 2015-16 season/120-22 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 150-22 when leading at the half, 42-78 when trailing and 12-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 104-15 when leading at the half, 28-35 when trailing and 7-3 when tied (Last 9 seasons)
- In the last 163 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 102 of them (63%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 132-41 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 34-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 73-62 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 58-9 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- Had a streak of 12 straight road wins (school record) come to an end (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won 14 straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 312 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.4 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- 35 straight games with 10 or more assists

MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- He is the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career
 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach 11 league wins in first season at the helm
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 61-84 (53-60 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- · Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage

Rock Hill, S.C. – Winthrop University Mark Prosser has been hired as the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history, announced Friday by the Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Ken Halpin.

Prosser has spent the last three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of threetime first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP. A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.




