### EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

#### WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS HIGH POINT

- Winthrop and High Point meet for the second time this season and 51st time overall
- Eagles hold a 35-15 lead in the all-time series and are 6-0 against the Panthers in the conference tournament (3-0 in the 1st round/quarterfinals)
- In the first meeting this season the Eagles fell 65-56 (Winthrop had won previous eight meetings)
- Winthrop held High Point to 27 percent shooting in the first half for a 29-26 lead at the break but the Panthers shot 56 percent in the second half
- Winthrop committed 22 turnovers in the first meeting, leading to 23 points by the Panthers
- . These same two teams met in the 2021 Big South quarterfinals as the Eagles won 83-54 behind a triple-double from Chander Vaudrin
- Winthrop and High Point met in the 2003 Big South Conference Title game with the Eagles earning an 80-64 win
- In six conference tournament meetings all-time, the Eagles have never allowed more than 65 points (57.3 ppg)
- In 50 meetings all-time the Eagles have scored 3,615 points (72.3 ppg) and the Panthers have scored 3,150 points (63.0 ppg)

#### ON THIS DATE (Mar. 4)

- Eagles are 11-3 all-time and 9-2 in the conference tournament
- The Eagles last played on Mar. 4 in the 2021 Big South Conference semifinals, earning an 82-61 win over Longwood to advance to the championship game
- Chandler Vaudrin led the Eagles to the win with 16 points, 9 assists and 8 rebounds
- In the 2016 Big South Tournament, the Eagles defeated Presbyterian College on this day in the quarterfinals behind 21 points from Jimmy Gavin and 19 from Xavier Cooks
- · On this day in 2010, the Eagles advanced to the Big South Championship game with a 61-46 win over 2nd-seeded Radford
- In 2006 Craig Bradshaw hit a hook shot with nine seconds remaining to lift the Eagles to a 51-50 victory over Coastal Carolina for the Big South Title

#### WINTHROP IN BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT

- Eagles are seeded 2nd for the 7th time in program history
- Hold an all-time record of 13-2 as the #2 seed
- Have won six straight conference tournament games and 10 of the last 12
- Looking for a third straight Big South Conference Tournament Title (Eagles last won three straight 2005-06/2006-07/2007-08)
- Last time the Eagles were seeded second they won the title in 2020
- All-Time the Eagles are 53-23 and 27-15 when playing on a neutral court
- The last neutral site tournament game for the Eagles came Mar. 7, 2019 in Buies Creek, N.C. and suffered a 77-63 loss to Charleston Southern
- Eagles have won their opening game of the tournament the last two season and eight of the last nine
- Winthrop holds the record for Big South Championships (13) and consecutive wins in conference tournament play (12)

#### **EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH**

- Have 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history
- Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall
- Won eight straight league games to end the regular season
- The Eagles are 31-3 in conference play over the last two seasons combined
- Winthrop is one of only four programs at the NCAA D1 level to have three or fewer conference losses in the last two seasons combined
- The other three teams are Gonzaga (28-1), South Dakota State (27-3) and Colgate (27-3) and all four teams have completed their conference slate for '21-22
- In 16 league games for the Eagles and their opponents combined for 90 ties and 89 lead changes
- Overcame a deficit of 10 or more four times in league play and won six games rallying from eight or more points (twice ralling from down 10 or more in 2nd half)
- Scored a season-high 61 points in the second half in the 92-88 loss at Longwood
- It was the most in a half against a league opponent since Jan. 5, 2019 at UNCA (61 in second half)
- In that same half the Eagles allowed 54 to Longwood, the first time since Dec. 30, 2020 the Eagles gave up 50 or more in a half
- It was the most allowed in a half against a league foe since allowing 53 in an 89-88 win at PC (2/15/20)
- Eagles had won nine straight regular season league games before the loss to High Point, the 6th longest streak in program history
- · Winthrop had won 32 straight games against Big South opponents while leading at the half before its leading at the half in the loss at High Point
- On Feb. 9 the Eagles scored 58 in the win over Radford, which was the lowest point total in a Winthrop win since Feb. 12, 2021 in a 55-47 win at Radford
- After defeating Campbell on Jan. 10, the Eagles have now won nine straight league openers
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 332-224 (.594)
- The 332 victories are the most by any Big South member
- Eagles played in their 550th regular season Big South in the win at Hampton
- Have led the league in scoring offense the last five seasons (Currently 2nd in the Big South)
- Over the last three seasons the Eagles are 46-6 in league play
- Have gone eight straight seasons with a winning record during league play and 19 of the last 23 seasons

#### TEAM NEWS

- Winthrop reached 21 wins in a season for the 11th time in program history (more 20-win seasons than anyone in Big South history)
- · Winthrop has shot 50 percent or better from the floor in the last three contests and six of the last seven
- In fact, they've did so in 11-of-16 conference games (five on the road)
- Eagles have won 22 of the last 23 meetings with programs from the state of South Carolina
- · Have won 16 of the last 19 meetings with programs from the state of North Carolina, 18-of-20 against league opponents (conference tourney included)
- In the last 23 meetings with programs from the state of Virginia the Eagles are 18-5
- Finished January with a loss at Longwood, but over the last three seasons the Eagles hold a record of 24-3 in the month and 50-12 in the last seven seasons
- Have an all-time record of 244-177 (.578) in the month of January
- Had a perfect February at 8-0 and are 222-144 all-time in the month of February
- Hold an all-time mark of 52-31 all-time in the month of March
- · Captured first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with the win at Washington on Nov. 27 (program's 11th win over a Power 5 opponent)
- Eagles connected on 16 threes in the loss at Washington State (Nov. 22), the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Scored 58 points in the second half at Washington State, the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan.
  16, 2020
- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailed by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team

### EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 267-254
- Through 29 games the Eagles have averaged 29.7 ppg from their bench (ranked T-10th nationally as of Mar. 2)
- Eagles had less than 10 points from their bench for the first time this season in the win at PC (8)
- In fact the Eagles went back-to-back games with just eight points off the bench but won both (at PC, vs. Gardner-Webb)
- For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Through 29 games this year the Eagles have 31 double-figure contributions off the bench
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 50-4 when leading at the half (108-13 since the start of the 2015-16 season/122-22 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 152-22 when leading at the half, 42-78 when trailing and 12-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 106-15 when leading at the half, 28-35 when trailing and 7-3 when tied (Last 9 seasons)
- In the last 164 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 103 of them (63%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 134-41 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 34-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 73-62 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 60-9 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

#### TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- Had a streak of 12 straight road wins (school record) come to an end (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won eight straight games overall
- Have won 16 straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 314 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.4 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- 37 straight games with 10 or more assists

#### MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- He is the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach 11 league wins in first season at the helm
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 63-84 (55-60 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

#### LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage
- Led the Big South in scoring for a 5th straight season
- Featured one of the premier rebounding teams in the country, finishing 9th in rebound margin (+8.7), 10th in rebounds per game and 14th in offensive rebounds (12.96)
- Finished second in the nation in bench points (36.0 ppg)
- Tied for first nationally in true road wins (10)

## MARK PROSSER

Rock Hill, S.C. – Winthrop University Mark Prosser has been hired as the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history, announced Friday by the Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Ken Halpin.

Prosser has spent the last three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of threetime first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP. A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.






