

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS GARDNER-WEBB

- Eagles and Runnin' Bulldogs meet for the third time this season and 40th all-time
- Winthrop swept the regular season series and has won five straight meetings
- This marks the 4th meeting all-time in the semifinals of the conference tournament as the Eagles have won all three
- The most recent meeting came in 2020 as the Eagles held on for a 78-66 win
- This marks the 17th meeting since the 2016-17 season (5th time in conference tourney)
- In 39 meetings all-time, the Eagles have scored 2,787 points (71.9 ppg) and Gardner-Webb has scored 2,070 points (68.5 ppg)
- In 39 meetings all-time there have been 21 games decided by six or fewer points

WINTHROP IN BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT

- Eagles are seeded 2nd for the 7th time in program history
- Hold an all-time record of 14-2 as the #2 seed
- Have won seven straight conference tournament games and 11 of the last 13
- Looking for a third straight Big South Conference Tournament Title (Eagles last won three straight 2005-06/2006-07/2007-08)
- Last time the Eagles were seeded second they won the title in 2020
- All-Time the Eagles are 54-23 and 28-15 when playing on a neutral court
- The last neutral site tournament game for the Eagles came Mar. 7, 2019 in Buies Creek, N.C. and suffered a 77-63 loss to Charleston Southern
- Eagles have won their opening game of the tournament the last two seasons and eight of the last nine
- Winthrop holds the record for Big South Championships (13) and consecutive wins in conference tournament play (12)

EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH

- Have 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history
- Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall
- Won eight straight league games to end the regular season
- The Eagles are 31-3 in conference play over the last two seasons combined
- Winthrop is one of only four programs at the NCAA D1 level to have three or fewer conference losses in the last two seasons combined
- The other three teams are Gonzaga (28-1), South Dakota State (27-3) and Colgate (27-3) and all four teams have completed their conference slate for '21-22
- In 16 league games for the Eagles and their opponents combined for 90 ties and 89 lead changes
- Overcame a deficit of 10 or more four times in league play and won six games rallying from eight or more points (twice rallying from down 10 or more in 2nd half)
- Scored a season-high 61 points in the second half in the 92-88 loss at Longwood
- It was the most in a half against a league opponent since Jan. 5, 2019 at UNCA (61 in second half)
- In that same half the Eagles allowed 54 to Longwood, the first time since Dec. 30, 2020 the Eagles gave up 50 or more in a half
- It was the most allowed in a half against a league foe since allowing 53 in an 89-88 win at PC (2/15/20)
- Eagles had won nine straight regular season league games before the loss to High Point, the 6th longest streak in program history
- Winthrop had won 32 straight games against Big South opponents while leading at the half before its leading at the half in the loss at High Point
- On Feb. 9 the Eagles scored 58 in the win over Radford, which was the lowest point total in a Winthrop win since Feb. 12, 2021 in a 55-47 win at Radford
- After defeating Campbell on Jan. 10, the Eagles have now won nine straight league openers
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 332-224 (.594)
- The 332 victories are the most by any Big South member
- Eagles played in their 550th regular season Big South in the win at Hampton
- Have led the league in scoring offense the last five seasons (Currently 2nd in the Big South)
- Over the last three seasons the Eagles are 46-6 in league play
- Have gone eight straight seasons with a winning record during league play and 19 of the last 23 seasons

TEAM NEWS

- Winthrop reached 22 wins in a season for the 9th time in program history (more 20-win seasons than anyone in Big South history)
- Winthrop has shot 50 percent or better from the floor in the last four contests and seven of the last eight
- In fact, they've did so in 11-of-16 conference games (five on the road)
- Eagles have won 22 of the last 23 meetings with programs from the state of South Carolina
- Have won 17 of the last 20 meetings with programs from the state of North Carolina, 19-of-21 against league opponents (conference tourney included)
- In the last 23 meetings with programs from the state of Virginia the Eagles are 18-5
- Finished January with a loss at Longwood, but over the last three seasons the Eagles hold a record of 24-3 in the month and 50-12 in the last seven seasons
- Have an all-time record of 244-177 (.578) in the month of January
- Had a perfect February at 8-0 and are 222-144 all-time in the month of February
- Hold an all-time mark of 53-31 all-time in the month of March
- Captured first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with the win at Washington on Nov. 27 (program's 11th win over a Power 5 opponent)
- Eagles connected on 16 threes in the loss at Washington State (Nov. 22), the most against a Power 5 opponent in program history
- It's also the first time the Eagles have ever lost a game when hitting 16 or more threes (15 total games)
- The 16 threes were tied for the 4th most in a single game in program history and the second most in a road game (Record is 17 at High Point Jan. 4, 2017)
- Scored 58 points in the second half at Washington State, the most by an Eagles team in a road game since posting 58 at Hampton in a 116-95 victory Jan. 16, 2020
- Started off 2-0 for a second straight season after an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer after rallying from a 15-point deficit (Trailing by nine with 52 seconds left)
- Eagles trailed by 11 points at the half as they rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit for the first time since Jan. 5, 2019
- That year they trailed UNC Asheville 31-19 in the conference opener
- Posted 110 points in the season-opener, the 8th most points scored in a single-game by a Winthrop team
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 267-254
- Through 30 games the Eagles have averaged 29.7 ppg from their bench (ranked 12th nationally as of Mar. 4)
- Eagles had less than 10 points from their bench for the first time this season in the win at PC (8)
- In fact the Eagles went back-to-back games with just eight points off the bench but won both (at PC, vs. Gardner-Webb)
- For the past two seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Through 30 games this year the Eagles have 31 double-figure contributions off the bench
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 51-4 when leading at the half (109-13 since the start of the 2015-16 season/123-22 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 9 seasons the Eagles are 153-22 when leading at the half, 42-78 when trailing and 12-3 when tied

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- In regular season Big South contests they are 106-15 when leading at the half, 28-35 when trailing and 7-3 when tied (Last 9 seasons)
- In the last 165 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 104 of them (63%)
- Over the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 134-41 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 34-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 73-62 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 9 seasons Winthrop is 60-9 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- Had a streak of 12 straight road wins (school record) come to an end (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won nine straight games overall
- Have won 16 straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 315 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.4 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- 38 straight games with 10 or more assists

MARK PROSSER

- In his first season as head coach of the Eagles and 5th season overall as a head coach
- He is the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach 11 league wins in first season at the helm
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach - 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 64-84 (56-60 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduated from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- Captured a second straight Big South Championship and earned a 12-seed in the NCAA Tournament
- It was the program's 13th Big South Championship and 11th NCAA Appearance
- Finished 5th in the final CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Received votes in both the AP and ESPN Coaches Top 25 final polls
- Eagles received votes in the final 2020-21 USA Today Coaches Poll (9 straight weeks) and AP Top 25 Poll (5 straight weeks)
- Posted an overall record of 23-2 after a 16-0 start
- Set a program record with 21 straight wins, one win shy of tying the Big South record with the 2010-11 Coastal Carolina team
- Eagles set a new standard with a program record .920 winning percentage
- Led the Big South in scoring for a 5th straight season
- Featured one of the premier rebounding teams in the country, finishing 9th in rebound margin (+8.7), 10th in rebounds per game and 14th in offensive rebounds (12.96)
- Finished second in the nation in bench points (36.0 ppg)
- Tied for first nationally in true road wins (10)
