- Posted 23 wins in 2021-22, the third straight season with 23 or more victories
- Winthrop was voted to finish 2nd in the Big South Conference preseason poll
- Hold an all-time record of 117-86 in the month of November
- Made the Big South Championship game in 2022, the third straight trip for the Eagles who have won two of the last three league
- Looking for a third straight Big South Title
- Mark Prosser enters his second season after leading the program to 23 wins in 2021-22
- Prosser had the most league wins by a Winthrop coach in their first season at the helm (14)
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past six seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21)





EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS AUBURN/SEC

- Eagles and Tigers meet for the 6th time as Auburn leads the series 5-1
- It is the first meeting since Nov. 24, 2017 when the Eagles fell 119-85 at Auburn
- The 119 points were the most points allowed by an opponent in program history
- This series started back in 1996 when the Eagles traveled to Auburn and suffered an 80-55 loss
- Winthrop faced the Tigers in its first ever NCAA Tournament appearance on Mar. 11, 1999 in Indianapolis as a 16th-seed and fell 80-41
- Eagles only win in the series came Dec. 22, 2012 in a 74-67 victory
- Winthrop is only 3-30 all-time against opponents from the SEC and 0-5 when the SEC team is nationall-ranked
- The win at Auburn on Dec. 22, 2012 is the last time the Eagles defeated an SEC opponent

ON THIS DATE

- Eagles are 1-4 all-time on this date with an 0-1 road record, 0-3 neutral site record
- The last time the Eagles played on Nov. 15 was in 2011 with a contest at Virginia as they fell 69-48
- In 2006 the Eagles faced #2 North Carolina at Time Warner Cable Arena in the Preseason NIT
- The Eagles led that game 38-30 at the half but ended up with a 73-66 loss as Torrell Martin led the Eagles with 25 points

EAGLES ON THE ROAD

- This is just the second road contest for the Eagles this season, as they opened the season with a 93-68 loss at Penn State
- Have an all-time road mark of 256-356 and 204-304 at the NCAA DI level
- Have been .500 or better on the road the last three seasons (27-14 record in that span)
- Over the last five seasons the Eagles are 53-33 on the road

LOOKING BACK AT 2021-22

- Finished with a 23-9 record and played in the Big South Tournament Championship Game for a 3rd straight year
- Earned 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history
- Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall
- Winthrop became one of only four programs at the NCAA D1 level to have three or fewer conference losses in the last two seasons combined (2020-21/2021-22)
- The other three teams are Gonzaga (28-1), South Dakota State (27-3) and Colgate (27-3)
- Had winning streaks of 10 straight and seven straight during the season
- Posted the first undefeated home record (13-0) since the 2006-07 team was 15-0 at home

PLAYER NEWS

- Through three games the Eagles have four regular players averaging in double-figures (Xavier McKelvy scored 11 in his only game played)
- Junior Kelton Talford leads the team with 18.3 ppg, 8.0 rpg and shooting 78 percent from the floor (13-of-16 at the line)
- He has been in double-figures in three straight games for the first time in his career
- Talford opened the season with 18 points, 7 rebounds at Penn State and in the middle of the week put up a career-best 23 points vs. Piedmont
- Senior Cory Hightower is coming off a season-high 20 points as he is second on the team in scoring at 16.7 ppg while leading in assists per game (4.3) and second in rebounding (6.0)
- He surpassed 700 career rebounds in the game against MTSU and is now five points shy of 1,400 in his career
- Hightower now has nine career games with 20 or more points and has reached the mark in three of his last six games
- Junior Sin'Cere McMahon matched Hightower with 20 points in the win over MTSU as he finished the game 10-for-10 from the free throw line (carer-high for makes/attempts)
- The 20 points matched his career-best and he is third on the team in scoring at 12.3 ppg and second in assists per game (2.3)
- Kasen Harrison, who is expected to play a key role on this year's squad, made his debut for the Eagles on Saturday after missing the first two games with an injury

TEAM NEWS

- Sitting at 2-1 after a victory over Middle Tennessee at home on Nov. 12
- Eagles finished the game 27-for-31 at the foul line and held the Blue Raiders to 37 percent shooting
- In the season opener at Penn State the Eagles allowed 18 three-pointers, the most since allowing 20 vs. Pfeiffer Nov. 13, 2018
- Winthrop has hit 11 triples in each of its first two contests and now have 10 or more threes in 16 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 12-4 record in those 16 contests)
- Coming off a 23 win season in Mark Prosser's first year at the helm
- It was the 8th time in program history the Eagles won at least 23 games in a single-season (more 20-win seasons than anyone in Big South history)
- Winthrop returns five players that saw action in 2021-22, two players returning that sat out last season and welcome eight newcomers
- Voted to finish second in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote)
- Eagles received five votes in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll
- Three of Winthrop's opponents (or potential) are currently ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25 (Furman 6th, IPFW 17th,

- Longwood 25th) and two received votes (Mercer/Campbell)
- Hold an all-time mark of 117-86 all-time in the month of November (at least a .500 record or better in nine straight seasons in November)
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 268-255
- Averaged 28.6 points per game from its bench in 2021-22 as Winthrop finished ranked 14th nationally (Cornell led at 36.1 ppg)
- For the past three seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 54-4 when leading at the half (112-13 since the start of the 2015-16 season/126-22 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 10 seasons the Eagles are 156-22 when leading at the half, 42-79 when trailing and 12-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 106-15 when leading at the half, 28-35 when trailing and 7-3 when tied (Last 9 seasons)
- In the last 168 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 105 of them (63%)
- Over the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 137-41 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 36-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 73-63 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 61-9 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Streak of consecutive road wins came to an end at Middle Tennessee (12 straight)
- Had a streak of 12 straight road wins (school record) come to an end (previous mark was 9 set by the 1980-81 team and also a stretch between the 2006-07/2007-08 seasons)
- Have won 18 straight home games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 320 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.6 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- Three straight year swith 20-plus victories

MARK PROSSER

- In his second season as head coach of the Eagles and 6th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach at least 11 league wins in first season at the helm (finished with 14)
- Guided the team to its first ever win over a PAC 12 opponent with an 82-74 win at Washington (11/27/21)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 67-86 (59-62 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser enters his second season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2,, 2021

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games.

He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018. Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament. "My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country.'

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the

quarterfinals of the conference tournament. Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history. While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year. In the summer of 2008. Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.


