# EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

### WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS USC UPSTATE

- Winthrop and USC Upstate meet for the 26th time as the Eagles have won 12 straight in the series
- Eagles are 12-0 against USC Upstate in meetings that both programs were NCAA D1 members
- Spartans led the series prior to both program's transition to D1 with a 8-5 advantage
- Four of the last five meetings during the regular season have come at the G.B Hodge Center
- Eagles lead the series 17-8 all-time and have won seven straight road meetings
- In three of the last five meetings, the Eagles have connected on 16 threes and have made 11 or more in four straight meetings
- In the last meeting at the G.B. Hodge Center the Eagles squeeked out a 95-91 overtime victory, the first overtime game in the series
- Winthrop has won seven of the last eight meetings by double-digits
- In 25 meetings all-time the Eagles have scored 1,899 points (75.96 ppg) and USC Upstate has scored 1,768 points (70.72 ppg)
- Eagles have reached 90 or more points in five of the last six meetings

### ON THIS DATE (Dec. 29)

- Hold an all-time record of 6-7 on this date, 2-5 on the road
- Last played on this date in 2018, picking up a 76-62 win over Prairie View A&M behind 17 points from Bjorn Broman
- In 2016, the Eagles opened leage play at Charleston Southern with an 84-68 win behind 27 points from Keon Johnson
- In 2007 the Eagles earned a neutral site victory over 19th-ranked Miami (76-70) as Chris Gaynor (21 points) and Taj McCullough (19 points) led the way

### **BIG SOUTH OPENERS**

- Winthrop has won nine straight league openers and are 20-17 all-time
- When opening league play on the road, the Eagles are 11-9 all-time
- Have won seven straight Big South openers on the road
- Have scored 80 or more points in the last four conference openers on the road
- Have won five of the last six league openers by double-figures

### EAGLES ON THE ROAD

- 0-6 on the road to start a season for the first time since 2008-09 (started 0-7)
- Eagles have lost eight straight non-conference road games after the loss at Duquesne
- Averaging 67.7 ppg while shooting 44 percent from the floor and 78 percent at the foul line
- Allowing 84.0 ppg while opponents are shooting 50 percent and have a +9.0 rebound margin
- Have an all-time road mark of 256-361 and 204-309 at the NCAA D1 level
- Have been .500 or better on the road in the previous three seasons (27-14 record in that span)
- Over the last five seasons the Eagles are 53-38 on the road

### ON THE ROAD IN BIG SOUTH

- In 2021-22 the Eagles were 6-2 on the road
- Averaged 75.4 ppg and allowed 72.1 ppg in league road games last season
- Eagles have now won 24 of the last 27 road games in league play
- Posted a perfect 10-0 mark on the road in 2020-21
- In league road games last year the Eagles had a +13.0 scoring margin and +11.7 rebound margin
- Have gone nine straight seasons with a .500 or better record on the road in league play (eight seasons with a winning record, one season at .500) Eagles have an all-time record of 142-137 in league road games

### LOOKING BACK AT 2021-22

- Finished with a 23-9 record and played in the Big South Tournament Championship Game for a 3rd straight year
- It was the 8th time in program history the Eagles won at least 23 games in a single-season (more 20-win seasons than anyone in Big South history)
- Earned 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history
- Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall
- Winthrop became one of only four programs at the NCAA D1 level to have three or fewer conference losses in the last two seasons combined (2020-21/2021-22)
- The other three teams are Gonzaga (28-1), South Dakota State (27-3) and Colgate (27-3)
- Had winning streaks of 10 straight and seven straight during the season
- Posted the first undefeated home record (13-0) since the 2006-07 team was 15-0 at home

### TEAM NEWS

- Wrapping up a four-game road trip in which the team has dropped the first three
- Coming off a loss at Duquesne in which the Eagles scored just 57 points on 38 percent shooting
- Eagles shot just 29 percent in the first half and ended with a season-low 21 first half points
- It was the lowest point total in a half by an Eagle team since Jan. 20, 2022 at Presbyterian (20)
- It was the second-lowest point total on the season (52 vs. Southern Miss is the lowest)
- After posting a season-low 52 points in the loss to Southern Miss, the Eagles responded by posting a season-high in points in the 101-87 win over Eastern Michigan
- It was the first 100-point game against a non-conference D1 opponent since a 102-95 win over Hampton on Nov. 14, 2015 and just the second since 1993
- Eagles lead the Big South in free throw percentage (.748), third in three-point field goal percentage (.362) and fourth in field goal percentage (.475)
- Winthrop is ranked 52nd nationally in free throw percentage
- Second in the conference in three-point field goals per game (8.6)
- Had home winning streak of 19 straight come to an end vs. Coastal Carolina, which is the first non-conference home loss since 2019 when the Eagles fell to Coastal
- Sitting at 5-8 for the first time since 2009-10 and the 5th time in program history
- The last three seasons the Eagles started 5-8, they reached the NCAA Tournament (2009-10/2001-02/1999-2000)
- Hold an all-time record of 770-588 as this will mark the 1,359th game in program history
- Have attempted more free throws than opponents in 9-of-13 games this season, last two games free throw attempts have been equal and have 63 more attempts at the line than opponents
- Only opponents to have more attempts were Coastal Carolina (26 attempts to 20 for Winthrop) and Furman (17-16)
- In the season opener at Penn State the Eagles allowed 18 three-pointers, the most since allowing 20 vs. Pfeiffer Nov. 13, 2018
- Winthrop hit a season-high 13 threes in the loss to Coastal Carolina and now have 10 or more threes in 18 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 13-5 record in those 18 contests)
- Winthrop returns five players that saw action in 2021-22, two players returning that sat out last season and welcome eight newcomers
- Voted to finish second in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote)
- Eagles received five votes in the preseason CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll and received nine votes in the first regular season Mid-Major Top 25 but fell out in the poll released on Nov. 21
- Hold an all-time mark of 130-144 all-time the month of December (12-7 the last three seasons)
- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 270-258

# EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Averaged 28.6 points per game from its bench in 2021-22 as Winthrop finished ranked 14th nationally (Cornell led at 36.1 ppg)
- For the past three seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- This season the team is getting just 17.8 ppg from the bench (mainly due to injuries and the lack of available personnel)
- personnel)

  The average of 17.8 ppg from its bench is currently ranked 259th (games through Dec. 27)

- Eagles only received three points from the bench in the loss at Furman, tying a season-low they set Nov. 19 in the loss at Mercer
- Bench contributed a season-high 39 points in the win over Eastern Michigan and had 35 against Toccoa Falls
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 57-6 when leading at the half (115-15 since the start of the 2015-16 season/129-24 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 10 seasons the Eagles are 159-24 when leading at the half, 42-83 when trailing and 12-4 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 106-15 when leading at the half, 28-35 when trailing and 7-3 when tied (Last 9 seasons)
- In the last 171 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 108 of them (63%)
- Over the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 139-44 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 37-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 73-66 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 62-10 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

### TEAM STREAKS

- · Have hit at least one three-point basket in 330 consecutive games
- Have connected on at least five threes in 20 straight games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.6 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- Three straight years with 20-plus victories
- Have lost eight straight non-conference road games
- Have won eight Big South regular season contests

### MARK PROSSER

- In his second season as head coach of the Eagles and 6th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach at least 11 league wins in first season at the helm (finished with 14)
- Guided the team to its first ever win over a PAC 12 opponent with an 82-74 win at Washington (11/27/21)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 70-93 (62-69 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

# MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser enters his second season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2,, 2021

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games.

He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018. Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament. "My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country.'

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the

quarterfinals of the conference tournament. Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history. While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year. In the summer of 2008. Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.
