TIP-INS

- Eagles have dropped four of their last five contests and looking to end a two-game skid
- Over the last five games Winthrop has averaged 65.6 ppg while allowing 71.8 ppg
- Have lost back-to-back league home games for the first time since the 2019-20 season when the team lost to Radford & Hampton (2/10 & 2/22)
- Eagles are 26-7 in the month of January the last four seasons combined
- Winner of this contest will keep pace with the upper half of the league standings
- Posted 23 wins in 2021-22, the third straight season with 23 or more victories
- Winthrop was voted to finish 2nd in the Big South Conference preseason poll
- Made the Big South Championship game in 2022, the third straight trip for the Eagles who have won two of the last three league titles
- Mark Prosser enters his second season after leading the program to 23 wins in 2021-22
- Prosser had the most league wins by a Winthrop coach in their first season at the helm (14)
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past six seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21)

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

- Eagles and Buccaneers meet for the first time this season and 77th time overall
- Winthrop has won six straight meetings and leads the all-time series 50-26
- The last three meetings at the Winthrop Coliseum have been decided by six points or less
- The team that leads at the half in the last 26 meetings has gone on to win 23 times
- In 76 meetings all-time, the Eagles have scored 5,600 points (73.68 ppg) and Charleston Southern has scored 5,214 points (68.61 ppg)

EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH

- Sitting 3-5 for the 4th time in program history and first time since the 1996-97 season
- Have lost two straight and looking to avoid the first three-game losing streak in league play since starting the 2017-18 season (lost three straight after opening league play with a win over High Point)
- In eight league games the Eagles are averaging 66.8 ppg and allowing 70.1 ppg
- Shooting 43 percent from the floor while opponents are shooting 50 percent
- Eagles have scored 66 or fewer points in three of the last four league games
- Winthrop managed just 52 points in the home loss to Radford
- It is the fewest points in by the Eagles against a league opponent since Mar. 2, 2018 in a 61-52 loss to Radford in the Big South semifinals
- The 52 points are the fewest in a regular season league contest since Jan. 15, 2014 in a 56-51 home loss to Gardner-Webb
- In two of the three league wins the Eagles have rallied from double-digit deficits to win
- Winthrop shot 79 percent from the floor in the first half against PC, the highest shooting percentage in a half since the 2021 title game against Campbell when the Eagles shot 79 percent in the second half
- Finished with 12 threes in the win over PC, which was the 5th straight win over a league opponent when hitting 10 or more threes
- Winthrop has also won 20 of the last 22 games over league opponents when connecting on 10 or more triples
- Earned 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history in 2021-22
- Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall last season
- The Eagles are 34-7 in conference play over the last three seasons
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 335-229 (.595)
- The 335 victories are the most by any Big South member
- Eagles played in their 550th regular season Big South in the win at Hampton
- Led the league in scoring offense five of the last six seasons and haven't been lower than 3rd since the team was 5th in scoring in 2013-14 (74.0)
- Over the last four seasons the Eagles are 49-10 in league play
- Have gone eight straight seasons with a winning record during league play and 19 of the last 23 seasons

AT HOME IN BIG SOUTH

- Have dropped back-to-back home games against Radford and Gardner-Webb
- Haven't lost three straight league games at home since the 1995-96 season
- Coming off a home loss in which the Eagles led by nine points with just under seven minutes remaining
- In four league contests at home the Eagles average 64.2 ppg and allow 65.2 ppg
- Winthrop is shooting 45 percent while opponents shoot 47 percent
- Since 2015-16 the Eagles have lost 12 conference home games with six of those losses coming against programs from the state of Virginia
- Among Big South programs, Radford has the most wins at the Winthrop Coliseum (4) since 2015-16
- In the conference home opener on Dec. 31, the Eagles overcame a 15-point second half deficit to defeat the UNCA, the first double-figure comeback against a league opponent at home since Jan. 22, 2022 against Gardner-Webb as the Eagles trailed by 10 that game
- Hold a record of 24-4 at home since the 2019-20 season
- Went 8-0 at home in 2021-22, which was the sixth time in program history the Eagles were undefeated at home in Big South play and the first since 2006-07
- All-time the Eagles hold a Big South regular season record of 193-88 (68%) at home
- Haven't lost more than two home league games since 2011-12
- In 2021-22, the Eagles averaged 74.0 ppg and shot 51 percent from the field while holding opponents to 65.2 ppg and 42 percent shooting
- In the last 10 seasons the Eagles are 71-18

AT HOME

- Had a 10-game home win streak against league opponents come to an end with the loss to Radford and have now lost two straight at the coliseum
- The last time Winthrop lost three straight home games was 2008-09
- In nine home games the Eagles have averaged 74.7 ppg and shot 48 percent from the floor while allowing 65.6 ppg and opponents are shooting 42 percent
- In 2021-22 the Eagles averaged 79.9 ppg while holding opponents to 65.9 ppg in home games
- The loss to Coastal Carolina on Dec. 30 ended the team's home winning streak at 19 in a row
- It was the third longest streak in program history, three behind the second-longest streak of 22 set back in 2004-05/2005-06
- The longest home winning streak is 24 from 2005-06/2007-08
- The loss to Coastal was the first time the Eagles scored 80 or more points in a home loss since 2-22-20 vs. Hampton (L, 87-81)
- Since becoming an NCAA D1 member, the Eagles are 158-10 when scoring 80 or more points at home
- Posted a perfect 13-0 record at home in 2021-22 that included non-conference wins over Mercer, Hartford and Furman
- Have won 10 or more home games for 10 straight seasons
- Hold an all-time record of 463-171 in home games and 416-159 all-time at the Winthrop Coliseum
- Since 1998-99 the Eagles are 285-63 at home (.824 winning percentage)
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles are 126-28 at home (.831 winning percentage)
- As an NCAA D1 member the Eagles are 383-142 in home contests

LOOKING BACK AT 2021-22

- Finished with a 23-9 record and played in the Big South Tournament Championship Game for a 3rd straight year
- It was the 8th time in program history the Eagles won at least 23 games in a single-season (more 20-win seasons than anyone in Big South history)
- Earned 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history
- Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall
- Winthrop became one of only four programs at the NCAA D1 level to have three or fewer conference losses in the last two seasons combined (2020-21/2021-22)
- The other three teams are Gonzaga (28-1), South Dakota State (27-3) and Colgate (27-3)
- Had winning streaks of 10 straight and seven straight during the season
- Posted the first undefeated home record (13-0) since the 2006-07 team was 15-0 at home

TEAM NEWS

- Winthrop started the year 5-5 over the first 10 games, but in the last 11 games are 3-8
- Sitting at 8-13 for just the third time in program history
- A win will put the Eagles at 9-13 for the 4th time in program history and a loss will put them at 8-14 for the 2nd time
- Opponents have shot 50 percent or better in four of the last five games
- Eagles outrebounded Gardner-Webb 41-29 (+12), which is the first time this season the Eagles have lost a game in which they outrebounded an opponent
- The last time the Eagles lost a game outrebounding an opponent by 10 or more rebounds was Feb. 13, 2020 at Gardner-Webb (+19 and lost 74-70)
- Winthrop has only outrebounded five opponents all season, but all five have been by double-digits
- After going 11-for-19 at the foul line against Radford (58%), the Eagles are 56-for-70 the last three (80%)
- Eagles are leading the conference in free throw shooting (.742) and rank 73rd nationally
- In the win over Asheville on Dec. 31, the Eagles trailed by 15 points in the second half and rallied from a 15 point deficit for the second time under Mark Prosser
- The last time the Eagles rallied from a 15 point deficit was Nov. 13 in an 88-85 overtime win over Mercer
- After posting a season-low 52 points in the loss to Southern Miss, the Eagles responded by posting a season-high in points in the 101-87 win over Eastern Michigan
- It was the first 100-point game against a non-conference D1 opponent since a 102-95 win over Hampton on Nov. 14, 2015 and just the second since 1993
- Had home winning streak of 19 straight come to an end vs. Coastal Carolina, which is the first non-conference home loss since 2019 when the Eagles fell to Coastal
- Hold an all-time record of 773-593 as this will mark the 1,367th game in program history
- Eagles tied a season-high with 31 free throw attempts in the loss at Upstate, the first time dropping a game with 30 or more free throw attempts since Dec. 7, 2019 vs. Coastal Carolina

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Eagles had won the 12 games prior in which they attempt 30 or more free throws
- In the season opener at Penn State the Eagles allowed 18 three-pointers, the most since allowing 20 vs. Pfeiffer Nov. 13, 2018
- Winthrop hit a season-high 13 threes in the loss to Coastal Carolina and now have 10 or more threes in 22 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 15-7 record in those 22 contests)
- Eagles received five votes in the preseason CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll and received nine votes in the first regular season Mid-Major Top 25 but fell out in the poll released on Nov. 21
- Hold an all-time mark of 245-182 all-time the month of January (26-7 the last four seasons)
- Averaged 28.6 points per game from its bench in 2021-22 as Winthrop finished ranked 14th nationally (Cornell led at 36.1 ppg)
- For the past three seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- This season the team is getting just 16.3 ppg from the bench (mainly due to injuries and the lack of available personnel)
- The average of 16.3 ppg from its bench is currently ranked 275th (games through Jan. 23)
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 58-8 when leading at the half (116-17 since the start of the 2015-16 season/130-26 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 10 seasons the Eagles are 151-22 when leading at the half, 41-74 when trailing and 10-4 when tied
- In Big South contests since 2013-14, the Eagles are 105-13 when leading at the half, 30-31 when trailing and 7-3 when tied
- In the last 174 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 109 of them (63%)
- Over the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 140-47 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 37-6 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- Have lost the last two games in which the team had 30 or more free throw attempts
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 73-68 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 63-10 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game
- Winthrop returns five players that saw action in 2021-22, two players returning that sat out last season and welcome eight newcomers
- Voted to finish second in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote)

TEAM STREAKS

- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 338 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.6 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- Have at least one block in 16 straight games
- Have committed at least 10 turnovers in 52 straight games (last game below 10 was Nov. 9, 2021 vs. Mary Baldwin - 9)
- Three straight years with 20-plus victories
- Nine straight seasons with a winning record (overall and Big South)

MARK PROSSER

- In his second season as head coach of the Eagles and 6th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach at least 11 league wins in first season at the helm (finished with 14)
- Guided the team to its first ever win over a PAC 12 opponent with an 82-74 win at Washington (11/27/21)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach - 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 73-98 (65-74 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduated from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

Mark Prosser enters his second season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2., 2021

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games.

He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018. Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Cata-mounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the

quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history. While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.

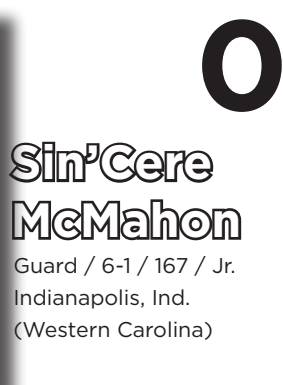

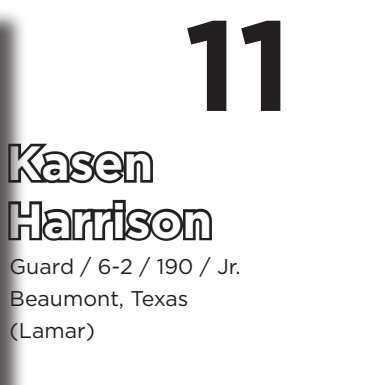
