# EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

#### WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS RADFORD

- Eagles and Highlanders meet for the 83rd time
- Radford holds a 41-40 all-time lead in the all-time series (The Radford win on Feb. 1, 2011 was vacated)
- Winthrop has won three straight meetings and four of the last five The Highlanders have won three of their last four trips to the Winthrop Coliseum
- In the last two meetings, neither team has scored more than 58 points and the Eagles have held the Highlanders under 50 points in those two meetings In 82 meetings the Eagles have scored 5,503 points (67.1 ppg) and Radford has scored 5,553 points (67.7 ppg)

#### ON THIS DATE (Jan. 11)

- Eagles are 10-6 all-time on this date, 6-2 at home and 5-6 in Big South play
- In 2020, the Eagles and Runnin' Bulldogs played one of the more memorable games in Big South history and the history of their programs as the Eagles won 99-95 in triple overtime in an ESPNU Wild Card matchup

  Gardner-Webb's Jose Perez phit a game-tying layup as time expired to force overtime and then Hunter Hale knocked down a corner three after a missed free throw as time
- expired to force a second OT
- In the second overtime, Chandler Vaudrin forced a three with a defender in his face and banked in a three to tie the game at 88-88 with 2.2 seconds left In 2014, the Eagles connected on 15 threes (the most by a Pat Kelsey led team at the time) in an 85-68 victory over Chrleston Southern

- Keon Moore, Keon Johnson and Christian Farmer each hit 5 threes in the game In 2006 the Eagles defeated UNC Asheville to extend its home winning streak to 22 games
- In that game Billy Houston tied the program record for blocks in a game with seven

- Picked up a 10th straight home win over a conference opponent after an 82-72 win over PC In two conference home games the Eagles are averaging 72.0 ppg and allowing 66.0 ppg Winthrop has shot 51 percent from the floor while opponents are shooting 47 percent

- Rebounding has been nearly even as opponents have a slight 65-64 edge

- Since 2015-16 the Eagles have lost 10 conference home games with six of those losses coming against programs from the state of Virginia

  Among Big South programs, Radford has the most wins at the Winthrop Coliseum (3) since 2015-16

  In the conference home opener on Dec. 31, the Eagles overcame a 15-point second half deficit to defeat the UNCA, the first double-figure comeback against a league opponent at home since Jan. 22, 2022 against Gardner-Webb as the Eagles trailed by 10 that game Hold a record of 24-2 at home since the 2019-20 season
- Went 8-0 at home in 2021-22, which was the sixth time in program history the Eagles were undefeated at home in Big South play and the first since 2006-07

- Haven't lost more than two home league games since 2011-12
  In 2021-22, the Eagles averaged 74.0 ppg and shot 51 percent from the field while holding opponents to 65.2 ppg and 42 percent shooting In the last 10 seasons the Eagles are 71-16

- Coming off a loss at Longwood after leading by nine at the half and by 12 in the early minutes of the second half
  Eagles are 2-2 in the league for the first time since 2015-16 and the 10th time in program history
  Four of the last six times the Eagles have sat 2-2 in league play they advanced to the Big South title game at the end of the season, but finished runner-up each time

- In four games the Eagles are averaging 69.2 ppg while shooting 45 percent from the field Allowing 71.8 ppg and opponents are shooting 51 percent Earned 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history in 2021-22 Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall last season The Eagles are 33-4 in conference play over the last three seasons

- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 334-226 (.596) The 334 victories are the most by any Big South member Eagles played in their 550th regular season Big South in the win at Hampton
- Led the league in scoring offense five of the last six seasons

  Over the last four seasons the Eagles are 48-7 in league play

  Have gone eight straight seasons with a winning record during league play and 19 of the last 23 seasons

#### AT HOME

- Won third straight home game after the win over PC

  In seven home games the Eagles have averaged 79.5 ppg and shot 50 percent from the floor while allowing 64.8 ppg and opponents are shooting 40 percent
  In 2021-22 the Eagles averaged 79.9 ppg while holding opponents to 65.9 ppg in home games
  The loss to Coastal Carolina ended the team's home winning streak at 19 in a row

- The loss to Coastal Carloma the tent as some winning streak at 17 in a 10m a 1 in a 10m a

- Have won 10 or more home games for 10 straight seasons
  Hold an all-time record of 463-169 in home games and 416-157 all-time at the Winthrop Coliseum
  Since 1998-99 the Eagles are 285-61 at home (.824 winning percentage)
  Since 2012-13 the Eagles are 126-26 at home (.831 winning percentage)
  As an NCAA D1 member the Eagles are 383-140 in home contests

#### LOOKING BACK AT 2021-22

- Finished with a 23-9 record and played in the Big South Tournament Championship Game for a 3rd straight year
  It was the 8th time in program history the Eagles won at least 23 games in a single-season (more 20-win seasons than anyone in Big South history)

- Earned 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history
  Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall
  Winthrop became one of only four programs at the NCAA D1 level to have three or fewer conference losses in the last two seasons combined (2020-21/2021-22)
  The other three teams are Gonzaga (28-1), South Dakota State (27-3) and Colgate (27-3)
  Had winning streaks of 10 straight and seven straight during the season

- Posted the first undefeated home record (13-0) since the 2006-07 team was 15-0 at home

#### TEAM NEWS

- Mark Prosser is coaching in his 50th game for Winthrop
- Looking to bounce back after road loss to Longwood
  Winthrop had a 12 point second half lead with 16:25 to play in the game and lost by double-figures
- It was the first loss holding a double-digit lead in a game since falling 63-61 at Elon on Dec. 15, 2021
  It was the first time doing so against league competition since leading Radford by 10 in an 87-81 road loss on Feb. 21, 2019 (had won 41 straight when leading by 10 or more vs. league opponents)
- After shooting 55 percent from the floor in the first half against the Lancers, the Eagles shot 39 percent in the second half
  Winthrop finished the final 14 minutes of the game 4-for-11 from the floor and committed 11 turnovers while Longwood finished the final 14 minutes 16-of-22 from the field
  Winthrop shot 79 percent from the floor in the first half against PC, the highest shooting percentage in a half since the 2021 title game against Campbell when the Eagles shot
- 79 percent in the second half
- 79 percent in the second man. In the last two games, the Eagles are 35-for-53 from the field (66%) in the first half and 17-of-29 behind the arc (59%) Finished with 12 threes in the win over PC, which was the 5th straight win over a league opponent when hitting 10 or more threes

- Winthrop has also won 19 of the last 21 games over league opponents with connecting on 10 or more triples
  Sitting 7-10 for the first time since 2012-13 and for the 4th time in program history

# MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser enters his second season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2,, 2021

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games.

He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018. Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament. "My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country.'

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the

quarterfinals of the conference tournament. Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history. While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year. In the summer of 2008. Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.


