

- Posted 23 wins in 2021-22, the third straight season with 23 or more victories
- Winthrop was voted to finish 2nd in the Big South Conference preseason poll
- Hold an all-time record of 118-89 in the month of
- Made the Big South Championship game in 2022, the third straight trip for the Eagles who have won two of the last three league titles
- Looking for a third straight Big South Title
- Mark Prosser enters his second season after leading the program to 23 wins in 2021-22
- Prosser had the most league wins by a Winthrop coach in their first season at the helm (14)
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past six seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21)

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY TOCCOA FALLS AND NON-D1 OPPONENTS

- This is the first ever meeting between Winthrop and Toccoa Falls
- Winthrop has won 58 straight games over Non-D1 opponents and are 101-8 all-time
- Eagles have posted 100 points in 12 of the last 16 games vs. Non-D1 teams
- The most points the Eagles have scored against a Non-D1 opponent is 134 (program record) vs. Pfeiffer on Nov. 13, 2018
- The most points the Eagles have allowed against a Non-D1 opponent is 99 (Pfeiffer 11/13/18)
- The fewest points the Eagles have allowed vs. a Non-D1 opponent is 34 vs. Limestone (1/2/08 in a 78-34 win)

ON THIS DATE (Nov. 29)

- Eagles are 6-6 all-time on this date and 4-3 at home
- The last time the Eagles played on this day was 2019 as they traveled to Cameron Indoor Stadium to take on #1 Duke as they fell 83-70
- In 2017 Xavier Cooks had 24 points and 10 rebounds to lead Winthrop to a 93-74 win at Furman (led 52-32 at half)
- Josh Ferguson also had a double-double in that contest with 17 points, 13 rebounds
- In 1985, the Eagles set a program record for points in a contest that stood for over 30 years with a 132-73 win over Morris College as Fred McKinnon poured in 40 points on 20 made field goals

EAGLES AT HOME

- With the victory over Middle Tennessee State on Nov. 12, the Eagles have now won 18 straight at the Winthrop Coliseum
- It's the third longest streak in program history, five behind the second-longest streak of 22 set back in 2004-05/2005-06
- The longest home winning streak is 24 from 2005-06/2007-08
- In addition to the winning streak the Eagles have won 30 of the last 31 at home
- Posted a perfect 13-0 record at home in 2021-22 that included non-conference wins over Mercer, Hartford and Furman
- Have won 10 or more home games for 10 straight seasons
- Hold an all-time record of 459-168 in home games and 412-156 all-time
- Since 1998-99 the Eagles are 281-60 at home (.823 winning percentage)
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles are 122-25 at home (.828 winning percentage)
- As an NCAA D1 member the Eagles are 379-139 in home contests
- In 2021-22 the Eagles averaged 79.6 ppg while holding opponents to 67.7 ppg in home games

LOOKING BACK AT 2021-22

- Finished with a 23-9 record and played in the Big South Tournament Championship Game for a 3rd straight year
- It was the 8th time in program history the Eagles won at least 23 games in a single-season (more 20-win seasons than anyone in Big South history)
- Earned 14 league wins for a 3rd straight season and sixth time in program history
- Won the South Division title and finished with the second-best record overall
- Winthrop became one of only four programs at the NCAA D1 level to have three or fewer conference losses in the last two seasons combined (2020-21/2021-22)
- The other three teams are Gonzaga (28-1), South Dakota State (27-3) and Colgate (27-3)
- Had winning streaks of 10 straight and seven straight during the season
- Posted the first undefeated home record (13-0) since the 2006-07 team was 15-0 at home

TEAM NEWS

- After posting a season-low 52 points in the loss to Southern Miss, the Eagles responded by posting a season-high in points in the 101-87 win over Eastern Michigan
- It was the first 100-point game against a non-conference D1 opponent since a 102-95 win over Hampton on Nov. 14, 2015 and just the second since 1993
- Sitting at 3-4 for the 7th time in program history and first time since 2014-15
- Hold an all-time record of 768-584 as this will mark the 1,353rd game in program history
- Eagles are shooting .737 at the free throw line, which ranks first in the Big South
- Have attempted more free throws than opponents in each of the first seven games this season
- In five of the seven games this year the Eagles have attempted at least 21 free throws (The 2021-22 team had 19 games with 20 or more free throw attempts)
- In the season opener at Penn State the Eagles allowed 18 three-pointers, the most since allowing 20 vs. Pfeiffer Nov. 13, 2018
- Winthrop hit a season-high 12 threes in the win over Eastern Michigan and now have 10 or more threes in 17 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 13-4 record in those 17 contests)
- Winthrop returns five players that saw action in 2021-22, two players returning that sat out last season and welcome eight newcomers
- Voted to finish second in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote)
- Eagles received five votes in the preseason CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll and received nine votes in the first regular season Mid-Major Top 25 but fell out in the poll released on Nov. 21
- Hold an all-time mark of 118-89 all-time in the month of November (at least a .500 record or better in nine straight seasons in November)

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Since joining the Big South in 1985-86, the Eagles have a non-conference record of 269-256
- Averaged 28.6 points per game from its bench in 2021-22 as Winthrop finished ranked 14th nationally (Cornell led at 36.1 ppg)
- For the past three seasons the Eagles have featured one of the top teams nationally in bench scoring
- In 2019-20 the team had 41 double-figure contributions off the bench and averaged 33.0 per game (2nd nationally)
- In 2020-21 the Eagles finished second again in bench scoring with 36.0 ppg and had 41 double-figure contributions (in nine fewer games than the previous year)
- This season the team is getting 20.6 ppg from the bench (which includes only 3 at Mercer and 12 vs. Southern Miss)
- Bench contributed a season-high 39 points in the win over Eastern Michigan
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 55-5 when leading at the half (113-14 since the start of the 2015-16 season/127-23 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 10 seasons the Eagles are 157-23 when leading at the half, 42-81 when trailing and 12-3 when tied
- In regular season Big South contests they are 106-15 when leading at the half, 28-35 when trailing and 7-3 when tied (Last 9 seasons)
- In the last 169 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 106 of them (63%)
- Over the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 138-43 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 37-4 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 73-64 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- In the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 62-9 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

TEAM STREAKS

- Have won 18 straight home games
- Have attempted and made more free throws than opponent in seven straight games
- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 324 consecutive games
- Six straight seasons averaging 8.6 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- Three straight years with 20-plus victories

MARK PROSSER

- In his second season as head coach of the Eagles and 6th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach at least 11 league wins in first season at the helm (finished with 14)
- Guided the team to its first ever win over a PAC 12 opponent with an 82-74 win at Washington (11/27/21)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 68-89 (60-65 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more

He joined Grego Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018. Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament. "My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country.'

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the

quarterfinals of the conference tournament. Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history. While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year. In the summer of 2008. Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg. the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.


