- Eagles captured a win in their Big South Conference opener for the 10th time in the last 11 seasons
- Looking to end two-game skid vs. Spartans who swept the regular season series in 2022-
- The win over Longwood was the 7th straight at home for the Eagles
- Finished non-conference play with nine wins for the second time in the last three seasons
- Last season Eagles were 4-4 in January, but hold a 29-7 mark over the last four seasons
- Winthrop coming off its first losing season since 2012-13 as it looks to bounce back
- Made the Big South Championship game in 2022, the third straight trip for the Eagles who have won two of the last three league titles
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past seven seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21) and played for the title in four of the last seven

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS USC UPSTATE

- Winthrop and USC Upstate meet for the 28th time
- The Eagles own a 17-10 lead in the all-time series
- Last season the Spartans swept the season series with the Eagles
- In the last meeting the Eagles fell 79-70 at home on Feb. 11
- Eagles are 12-2 all-time against the Spartans with both programs NCAA D1 members
- In 27 meetings all-time, the Eagles have scored 2,031 points (75.2 ppg) and the Spartans have scored 1,917 points (71.0 ppg)
- Winthrop has scored 90 or more points against Upstate in five of the last eight meetings

ON THIS DAY

- Hold a record of 6-7 overall, 3-5 in away games, 2-3 in the Big South and 1-2 in Big South road games
- In 2007, the Eagles posted 108 points in a 31 point victory at home over VMI behind 22 points from Antwon Harris and 21 points from Craig Bradshaw (both off the bench)
- In 1997 the Eagles earned a home non-conference win over Florida Atlantic (79-72)
- In 1996 the Eagles opened conference play with a 69-63 win at UMBC, which was the start of a 3-0 start to league play

ON THE ROAD IN BIG SOUTH

- Were 4-5 in league play last season while averaging 71.1 ppg while allowing 72.4 ppg
- Have won the last two league road games and 28 of the last 36
- Last season ended a streak of .500 or better on the road in league play to nine straight seasons
- Under Prosser the Eagles are 10-7 in two seasons on the road
- Eagles have an all-time record of 146-142 in league road games

EAGLES ON THE ROAD

- Have dropped three straight road games and are sitting 2-5 on the season
- Picked up first road win of the season on Dec. 5 with a 90-87 victory over Coastal Carolina
- Opened the season on the road with a 78-56 loss at Clemson and fell at Georgia, 78-69
- Have an all-time road mark of 261-371 and 209-318 at the NCAA D1 level
- Have been .500 or better on the road in the previous three seasons (28-14 record in that span)
- Over the last six seasons the Eagles are 58-48 on the road
- Averaging 68.9 ppg while allowing 75.0 in six road games (Averaged 71.0 ppg on the road last season while allowing 77.5 ppg)
- Shooting .402 from the field (opponents .434), .700 at the free throw line and getting outrebounded 37.1-35.7
- Winthrop has 29 more free throw attempts on the road than opponents

EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH

- Overcame an 11-point deficit to earn a 68-60 overtime win against Longwood in the conference opener
- It was the second straight rally from a double-digit vs. Longwood at home (19 down in 2021)
- Finished the regular season 10-8 in the conference and a three-way tie for fourth place
- Eagles secured their 10th straight season with a winning record in league play
- Have now won 10 or more conference games for the 10th straight season
- Winthrop has won 27 of the last 29 games over league opponents when connecting on 10 or more triples
- The Eagles are 42-10 in conference play over the last four seasons and 57-13 over the last five
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 343-232 (.596)
- The 343 victories are the most by any Big South member
- Led the league in scoring offense five of the last seven seasons

TEAM NEWS

- Coming off a 68-60 overtime victory over Longwood, which was a second straight win overall and seventh straight at home
- The Eagles have now won their last eight overtime games
- Ranked Top 50 in bench scoring heading into the Longwood game, which the Eagles finished with just 11 bench points
- As of games through Jan. 4 the Eagles rank 56th nationally in bench scoring (27.56 per game)
- It was the fewest points by the Eagles in an overtime win since defeating Furman 58-57 on Nov. 30, 2016
- Ended a three-game skid with a win over Toccoa Falls, scoring 113 points (8th most points scored in a single-game in program history)
- Eagles became the 4th Big South team to reach 10 wins, joining Longwood (12), High Point (12), and Radford (10) The win over Toccoa Falls gave the Eagles nine non-conference victories for the second time in three seasons
- In the loss at Florida State, the Seminoles attempted 42 free throws
- It was the first game all season an opponent attempted more free throws than the Eagles and was the first time since since Nov. 15, 2016 at Manhattan an opponent attempted
- Eagles held FSU to just 32 percent shooting from the field, but lost the game
- It was the first loss when holding an opponent to 32 percent or less since falling 69-64 to ETSU on Nov. 24, 2022 at home
- As of games through Jan. 4, the non-conference D1 opponents for the Eagles have a combined record of 74-73 with
- During the Eagles four-game win streak earlier this season, the team scored 85 or more points in each game
- It was the first four-game stretch of 80 or more points since December of 2022 and the first with 85 or more points since the 2017-18 season when the team scored 85 or more in six straight games
- This is the program's 1,394th game as it holds an all-time record of 790-603
- Hold an all-time mark of 124-92 in the month of November, 135-148 in the month of December and 248-182 in January
- Have attempted 150 more free throws than opponents and have made more (309) than opponents have attempted (284)
- While the Eagles are shooting 71 percent from the foul line, opponents are shooting 76 percent
- That is the 15th highest opponent free throw percentage at the NCAA D1 level (as of Jan. 5, 2024)
- Shooting .719 from the free throw line in home games while shooting .700 in road games
- In games won the Eagles are 203-of-282 (72%) at the foul line, while in losses they are 106-of-152 (70%)
- Sitting 10-6 for the 5th time in program history
- A win would make the Eagles 11-6 for the 6th time in program history and a loss would make them 10-7 for an 6th time
- In the win over Coastal Carolina the Eagles posted 90 points for a second straight game, first time with back-to-back games scoring 90 or more since since last year when they scored 101 vs. E. Michigan and 99 against Toccoa Falls
- In the win over Coastal the Eagles had 28 offensive rebounds, the most since grabbing 26 on Jan. 29, 2021 vs. UNC Asheville at home
- Secured a .500 or better record in the month of November for an 11th straight season
- Won five games in November, the most since the 2013-14 season (5)
- It is just the 8th time in program history the team won five games in November
- Started the month of December 3-0 for the first time since 2020-21 when the team opened the season 16-0
- Allowed 80 or more points for the first time all season against Coastal Carolina (87)
- It was also the most points allowed in a win (no OT) since a 101-87 win over E. Michigan in Cancun on Nov. 22, 2022
- Entered the 2023-24 season the Eagles have a home winning percentage of .669, ranked 31st among D1 programs over the previous 10 seasons
- Eagles had a season-high 15 steals in the win over Brevard (Tied for 2nd among for most by a Big South member)
- The last time Winthrop had 15 or more steals in a game was Dec. 6, 2016 when it had 20 vs. Greensboro College
- Winthrop returns four starters, three players that have played a key role in the past as a starter or reserve and three transfers that are expected to make an immediate impact Eagles retained the bulk of its starting lineup led by Big South First Team All-Conference selection Kelton Talford as well as Chase Claxton, Kasen Harrison and Sin'Cere
- Voted to finish third in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote and just two total votes behind second-place Radford)
- Clemson was the first of four Power 5 road contests the Eagles face this season and the first of two opponents from the ACC

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- The other meetings were at Georgia (Nov. 24), at South Carolina (Dec. 19) and at Florida State (Dec. 22)
- Since 2016-17 the Eagles are 17-4 in home games during the month of November, 29-17 in December and 23-6 in January
- Winthrop has 10 or more threes in 33 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 26-7 record in those 33 contests)
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 72-9 when leading at the half (130-18 since the start of the 2015-16 season/144-27 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 11 seasons the Eagles are 165-23 when leading at the half, 43-84 when trailing and 10-4 when tied
- In Big South contests since 2013-14, the Eagles are 110-13 when leading at the half, 33-35 when trailing and 7-3 when tied
- In the last 190 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 117 of them (62%)
- Over the last 11 seasons Winthrop is 155-55 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 42-9 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 75-70 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- Have won last four games attempting 30 or more free throws after having lost 4-of-5 prior
- In the last 11 seasons Winthrop is 72-10 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles have more wins than any other Big South Conference school (233), 33 more than the next team (Radford - 200)

TEAM STREAKS

- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 364 consecutive games
- Seven straight seasons averaging 8.6 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- Have at least one block in 15 straight games
- Now have 11 straight seasons finishing with a winning record in conference play
- Have won seven straight home games
- Streak of at least one block in 27 straight games came to an end at Clemson

LOOKING BACK AT 2022-23

- Winthrop suffered its first losing season since 2012-13, finishing the 2022-23 campaign 15-17
- Battled through a number of injuries that started with the loss of four-year starter Michael Anumba in the preseason
- That led to 11 different starting lineups throughout the season
- Offensively the Eagles averaged 73.8 ppg, the lowest scoring average since 2014-15 and allowed the most points (74.3 ppg) since 2018-19
- When the Eagles scored at least 70 points, they held a record of 14-5 Eagles dropped their opening game of the Big South Conference Tournament with a quarterfinals loss to Radford (78-69)
- Finished the season with 283 three-pointers, the sixth most made in a single-season in program history (averaged 8.84 per
- The 8.84 threes per game ranked 39th nationally and led the Big South Conference
- For the first time since 2016-17 the team had more turnovers than assists (366-447)
- Led the Big South in free throw percentage (.739), which was the third best in program history for a single-season

- In his third season as head coach of the Eagles and 7th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching
- Mark Prosser is coaching in his 196th game (168th at NCAA D1 level)
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/ Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach at least 11 league wins in first season at the helm (finished with 14)
- Guided the team to its first ever win over a PAC 12 opponent with an 82-74 win at Washington (11/27/21)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 90-108 (85-85 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser enters his third season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2., 2021.

The Eagles battled through a injury-riddled 2022-23 and finished the season 15-17 overall and 10-8 in the Big South.

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games. He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford

posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/ turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.


