## WINTHROP

#### **TIP-INS**

- Eagles hosting their first multi-team event (MTE) since 2003 when they hosted the Costner Brothers - Winthrop Shootout
- The other teams involved were Hampton and Samford
- Despite the games being played outside of the Winthrop Coliseum, these will be counted as home games for the Eagles
- Winthrop coming off its first losing season since 2012-13 as it looks to bounce back
- The last victory on the road in a season opener for the Eagles came Nov. 7, 2019 at Hartford
- Made the Big South Championship game in 2022. the third straight trip for the Eagles who have won two of the last three league titles
- Mark Prosser begins his third season
- Prosser led the Eagles to 23 wins and the Big South Championship game in his first season
- Winthrop has won the Big South Conference Title three out of the past seven seasons (2016-17 / 2019-20 / 2020-21) and played for the title in four of the last seven



## **EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM**

#### WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSES HOLY CROSS

- This is the first meeting against Holy Cross
- It is also the first time the Eagles are facing an opponent from the Patriot League

#### WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSES IUPUI

- All-time the Eagles are 1-0 against the Jaguars
- The one meeting came in the 2005 season opener in Milwaukee, Wisc. at the 44th Blue & Gold Classic hosted by Marquette
- The Eagles won the game 73-50 and went on to take the 44th Blue & Gold Classic with a 71-64 victory over Marquette

#### WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSES ELON

- All-time the Eagles are 11-3 against Elon as they meet for the 15th time
- Elon won the last meeting 63-61 on Dec. 15, 2021
- Winthrop is 7-9 all-time against opponents from the CAA

#### AT HOME

- Eagles are coming off a 74-72 loss to Drexel
- Have won the last six games following a home loss (dating back to the 2019-20 season)
- Last year the Eagles were 4-1 at home in non-conference matchups
- Have earned 10 or more wins at home in 11 straight seasons
- The longest home win streak in program history is 24 from 2005-06/2007-08
- Hold an all-time record of 468-173 in home games and 421-161 at the Winthrop Coliseum
- Since 1998-99 the Eagles are 290-65 at home (.819 winning percentage)
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles are 131-30 at home (.818 winning percentage)
- As an NCAA D1 member the Eagles are 387-144 in home contests

#### LOOKING BACK AT 2022-23

- Winthrop suffered its first losing season since 2012-13, finishing the 2022-23 campaign 15-17
- . Battled through a number of injuries that started with the loss of four-year starter Michael Anumba in the preseason
- That led to 11 different starting lineups throughout the season
- Offensively the Eagles averaged 73.8 ppg, the lowest scoring average since 2014-15 and allowed the most points (74.3 ppg) since 2018-19
- When the Eagles scored at least 70 points, they held a record of 14-5
- Eagles dropped their opening game of the Big South Conference Tournament with a quarterfinals loss to Radford (78-69)
- Finished the season with 283 three-pointers, the sixth most made in a single-season in program history (averaged 8.84 per game)
- The 8.84 threes per game ranked 39th nationally and led the Big South Conference
- For the first time since 2016-17 the team had more turnovers than assists (366-447)
- · Led the Big South in free throw percentage (.739), which was the third best in program history for a single-season

#### **TEAM NEWS**

- Looking to avoid first 1-3 start since the 2008-09 season
- Eagles were just 3-for-13 from behind the arc in the game
- It was the fewest made threes in a game since Feb. 12, 2022 vs. PC when the Eagles were 3-for-16 in a home win
- The 13 three-point attempts are the fewest in a game since the team attempted 14 at Gardner-Webb on Jan. 20, 2016 in a road win
- Eagles had 15 steals in the win over Brevard
- The last time Winthrop had 15 or more steals in a game was Dec. 6, 2016 when it had 20 vs. Greensboro College
- This game is the third of five straight games in the confines of Rock Hill
- Mark Prosser is coaching in his 186th game (158th at NCAA D1 level)
- Winthrop returns four starters, three players that have played a key role in the past as a starter or reserve and three transfers that are expected to make an immediate impact
- Eagles retained the bulk of its starting lineup led by Big South First Team All-Conference selection Kelton Talford as well as Chase Claxton, Kasen Harrison and Sin'Cere McMahon
- Voted to finish third in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote and just two total votes behind second-place Radford)
- · Clemson was the first of four Power 5 road contests the Eagles face this season and the first of two opponents from the ACC
- They will also travel to Georgia (Nov. 24), South Carolina (Dec. 19) and Florida State (Dec. 22)
- This is the program's 1,381st game as it holds an all-time record of 781-599
- · Hold an all-time mark of 120-91 in the month of November and have been .500 or better the last 10 seasons
- Since 2016-17 the Eagles are 13-4 in home games during the month of November
- Winthrop has 10 or more threes in 29 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 22-7 record in those 29 contests)
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 64-9 when leading at the half (122-18 since the start of the 2015-16 season/136-27 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 11 seasons the Eagles are 157-23 when leading at the half, 43-79 when trailing and 10-4 when tied
- In Big South contests since 2013-14, the Eagles are 110-13 when leading at the half, 32-34 when trailing and 7-3 when tied
- In the last 182 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 112 of them (62%)
- Over the last 10 seasons Winthrop is 146-52 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 38-9 when attempting 30 or more and 7-0 when attempting 40 or more
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 75-69 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- Have lost four of the last five games in which the team had 30 or more free throw attempts
- In the last 11 seasons Winthrop is 68-10 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles have more wins than any other Big South Conference school (225), 32 more than the next team (Gardner-Webb 193)

#### PLAYER NEWS

- Kasen Harrison had 19 points vs. Drexel and now has double-figures in eight of his last nine games
- Kelton Talford posted a season-high 21 points in the win over Brevard, the 11th 20-point game of his career
- Talford has scored 20 or more points in five of his last nine games

## **EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM**

- Talford surpassed 900 career points (936) and joined the 500 rebound club vs. Drexel (502)
- He is the 104th player in Big South Conference history to reach the mark
- Talford is also a 2023-24 First Team Preseason All-Conference selection
- Talford's 119 free throws made last season rank 11th for a single-season
- McMahon and Harrison were voted to the 2023-24 Second Team All-Conference
- McMahon was third on the team in scoring last season, setting career-highs in ppg (13.4) and three-point field goals made (73)
- His 73 triples were the 11th most in a single-season
- McMahon was one of just two players to play in all 32 games last season
- Harrison became the starting point guard when Isaiah Wilson suffered a season-ending injury seven games
  into the 2022-23 season and ended up settling into the role finishing the season with 11.5 ppg, 2.4 rpg, 3.8 apg
  and 1.2 spg while shooting 48 percent from the floor
- Harrison closed out his season with a career-high 26 points in the loss to Radford in the quarterfinals
- Claxton set career-highs in assists (31), blocks (36) and steals (33) last season and was five short of his career-best in total rebounds (125)
- K.J. Doucet's 12 points at Clemson pushed him past 900 career points (925)

#### TEAM STREAKS

- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 351 consecutive games
- Seven straight seasons averaging 8.6 three-pointers per game or more as a team
- Streak of at least one block in 27 straight games came to an end at Clemson
- Now have 11 straight seasons finishing with a winning record in conference play
- Have won five straight home openers

#### MARK PROSSER

- In his third season as head coach of the Eagles and 7th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach at least 11 league wins in first season at the helm (finished with 14)
- Guided the team to its first ever win over a PAC 12 opponent with an 82-74 win at Washington (11/27/21)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 81-104 (73-78 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

# MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser enters his third season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2., 2021.

The Eagles battled through a injury-riddled 2022-23 and finished the season 15-17 overall and 10-8 in the Big South.

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games. He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford

posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/ turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.


