- Have won two straight meetings, but 2-3 in the last five vs. Radford
- Earned 10 wins prior to league play for first time since 2015-16
- On Nov. 17 the Eagles captured the program's 800th win all-time (807-615)
- The victory was also the 100th career win for head coach Mark Prosser
- Eagles secure a winning record in the month of December with a win for second straight year and 5th time in the last six seasons
- Winthrop is 253-185 all-time in the month of January







Mark Prosser HEAD COACH



WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS RADFORD

- Winthrop and Radford meet for the 88th time
- Eagles swept the regular season series with Radford in 2023-24 after the Highlanders won all three meetings in 2022-23
- Radford leads the all-time series 44-42 (Radford win 2/1/11 vacated) and have won three of the last five meetings
- Winthrop has won four of its last five road games at Radford
- In the last 21 regular season meetings, the road team has won 12 times (Winthrop 6-5, Radford 6-4)
- In 87 meetings all-time the Eagles have scored 5,867 points (67.4 ppg) and the Highlanders have scored 5,923 points (68.1 ppg)

ON THE ROAD IN BIG SOUTH

- Finished 4-4 in league play last season with the final road loss coming at High Point in a 100-96 overtime loss
- Eagles have won 32 of the last 45 conference road games
- Won its first conference road game in 2023-24 at USC Upstate and Winthrop has won its first conference road game in five of the last six seasons
- Had 63 more free throw attempts than opponents in 2023-24
- Averaged 81.0 ppg while shooting 49 percent and opponents averaged 78.0 ppg and shot 45 percent
- In 2022-23 the Eagles had a streak of .500 or better on the road in league play to nine straight seasons come to an end
- Under Prosser the Eagles are 14-11 in three seasons on the road
- Eagles have an all-time record of 150-146 in league road games
- In 2022-23 the Eagles were 4-5 in league play while averaging 71.1 ppg while allowing 72.4 ppg

EAGLES ON THE ROAD

- Picked up first road win of the season, 86-78 at Queens on Dec. 3
- Three losses on the road are vs. Power 4 opponents in Virginia Tech (58-52), Louisville (76-61) and Florida State (82-64)
- Have an all-time road mark of 266-379 and 214-326 at the NCAA D1 level
- Over the last seven seasons the Eagles are 63-56 on the road
- Averaging 65.8 ppg while shooting 36 percent from the field
- Allowing 73.5 ppg and opponents are shooting 45 percent
 Have seven more free throw attempt than opponents this season (92-85), averaging 23.0 attempts per road game and shooting just 59 percent
- Winthrop had 92 more free throw attempts on the road than opponents (averaging 26.9 attempts per road game) in 2023-24

EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH

- Opened league play with a win for the second straight season and have won 11 of the last 12
- The 95 points vs. USC Upstate tied for the second-most scored in a Big South opener, which happened to be against USC Upstate in 2020 The record is 108, which they acheived vs. VMI in 2007
- Looking for a 2-0 start for the second straight season and the 6th time in the last seven seasons
- Currently lead the league in scoring (85.6 ppg) and steals (8.6)
 Last year the Eagles started league play 4-0 for the first time since 2021-22 and the 4th time in the last five seasons
- Finished with an 8-8 mark for a 4th place finish in the standings
- Have 12 straight seasons with at least a .500 or better record in conference
- It was the 8th 4-0 start in program history (in 2006-07 the Eagles went 14-0 in league play)
- The Eagles are 50-18 in conference play over the last five seasons and 65-21 over the last six
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 351-239 (.594)
- The 351 victories are the most by any Big South member

LOOKING BACK AT 2023-24

- Season ended with a 69-56 loss to 5th-seeded Longwood, the eventual Big South Champion
- Returned 4-of-5 starters from last year's team that was 17-15 overall
- All four returning starters were also the Top 4 in scoring from from 2023-24
- Two-Time All-Big South First Team selection Kelton Talford is the top returner as he led the team with 14.1 ppg and 5.8 rpg
- K.J. Doucet was second on the team in scoring at 12.4 ppg and second on the team with 51 made threes
- Kasen Harrison was also in double-figures at 11.3 ppg and led the team with 3.8 apg (ranked 3rd in Big South)
- Nick Johnson averaged 10.4 ppg and led the team with 44 steals, while ranking 4th in the Big South at 1.4 per game

- Eagles reached 90-plus points for the sixth time this season after defeating USC Upstate 95-76
- Used a 25-0 second half run to open the game up, which is a season-best run The previous best was a 21-0 run in the win over Bob Jones
- The win over Upstate was the 10th home win of the season, which is 10 or more home wins for a 13th straight season
- Reached 10 wins before conference play for first time since 2015-16 (1-of-4 Big South programs with 10 or more this season) Winthrop has won 10 of the last 11 Big South Conference openers with the lone loss coming to USC Upstate in 2022 (70-62)
- Opened Big South play with a 68-60 overtime win against Longwood last season
- Posted the 44th all-time 100 point game in the 102-97 victory over Mercer (42-2 all-time)
- It was the 18th 100-point game vs. a D1 opponent as the Eagles are 16-2 in those games
- Of the Eagles non-conference D1 opponents, eight of them have winning records as of Jan. 2
 Eagles have five 1,000 point scorers on this year's roster, tied for the 3rd most in the nation (D1) as Minnesota/Ole Miss lead the way with seven Teams with six are Alabama and Kentucky while Winthrop, Auburn, Gonzaga, Kansas, Oklahoma State UC San Diego and Xavier have five
- In the win over Bob Jones, Winthrop connected on 12 threes, the third time with 10 or more in a game this season (all three vs. Non-D1 opponents)
- In the first half of the game at FSU, Kelton Talford grabbed an offensive rebound and made a layup which was the 100,000th point in the history of the
- Talford has over 1,500 of those points personally and ranks 4th all-time in program history
- The 2023-24 team set the NCAA D1 program record for free throws made (601) and free throws attempted (856) for a single-season
- The 18.8 free throws made per game were a program record, as were the 26.8 free throw attempts per game
- Attempted 238 more free throws than opponents and made 601, which was nearly as many as opponents attempted (618)
- Winthrop led the nation in free throw attempts per game (26.8)
- Eagles finished 9th in the nation in total free throw attempts, 16th in free throws made
- Through 16 games this year the Eagles are averaging 31.3 free throw attempts a game and have attempted 164 more free throws than their opponents
- The 31.3 free throw attempts lead the nation in attempts per game (games through Jan.2) and are just 1-of-2 teams averaging 30 or more
- Winthrop has made 335 free throws for 20.9 per game which ranks 2nd nationally
- Eagles have almost made more free throws than opponents have attempted (335-336)
- In the win over Mercer, the Eagles attempted 48 free throws, the 5th game this season in which they have attempted 40 or more
- The '23-24 team had just two games all season with 40 or more free throw attempts despite setting program's D1 record for free throws made and free throws attempted
- In the win over Coastal, the Eagles had just five turnovers, the first time since Mar. 8, 2015 against Coastal Carolina in the 2015 Big South Title Game (lost 81-70)
- That season the Eagles had 10 games with fewer than 10 turnovers (have three so far this season)
- Picked up first road win of the season with an 86-78 win at Queens on Dec. 3
- Was the first non-conference road game win in the state of North Carolina since Nov. 22, 2010 when the Eagles won 83-74 at Wake Forest

Mark Prosser coached his 100th game as head coach of the Eagles on Nov. 15 and captured his 100th career win the same day

The win also marked the 800th in program history

Eagles got after it defensively vs. LIU, recording 10 blocks and getting 12 steals while holding LIU to 65 points (tied for fewest points allowed by the Eagles this season)

It is the first time this season the Eagles have had double-digit blocks and steals in the same game

- In fact it's the first time Winthrop has had 10 or more blocks in a single-game since Feb. 10, 2018 as they had 10 at High Point
- The last time the Eagles had 10 or more blocks and 10 or more steals in the same game was Jan. 7, 2010 vs. VMI (11 blocks, 13 steals)

Eagles went 2-1 in the Rock Hill Classic and all three matchups being one possession games

- The 100th win for Prosser came on a buzzer-beater by junior transfer Bryce Baker with a corner three
- It was the first buzzer beater win for the Eagles since Keon Johnson's jumper as time expired in an 86-84 victory at Radford on Jan. 13, 2016
- In games versus D1 opponents this season the Eagles are 8-5 overall and averaging 80.2 ppg while allowing 78.0 ppg
- Through 16 games the Eagles have a +5.3 advantage on the glass and are averaging 14.4 offensive rebounds per game (12.8 per game vs. D1 opponents)
 The first loss of the season came at Virginia Tech, 58-52

The loss came two days after the Eagles earned their 2-0 start since the 2021-22 season after the win over Little Rock

The 58 points were the second-lowest the Eagles have ever allowed vs. an ACC opponent

- This was the first loss by the Eagles when holding an opponent under 60 points since falling 57-55 to UNC Asheville at home on Jan. 29, 2021
- In the win over Little Rock, the Eagles opened the second half on a 16-4 run for a double-digit lead and never looked back

It was the second straight game this season, the Eagles dominated the glass 52-32

It was also the second straight game the Eagles had 20-plus offensive rebounds (21 vs. Little Rock)

Eagles opened with a 60-point victory over Piedmont on Nov. 4

The 60-point win was the second-largest margin of victory in program history

- Hauled in 63 rebounds vs. Piedmont, first time grabbing 60 or more rebounds in a game since 2019 vs. Pfeiffer
- The Eagles matched a program record for offensive rebounds with 28 that was set Dec. 2, 2023 against Coastal Carolina

Also finished with 64 points in the paint and 38 second-chance points

- Hold an all-time mark of 130-95 in the month of November, 139-150 in the month of December, 253-185 in
- January and 230-152 in February Since 2016-17 the Eagles are 23-5 in home games during the month of November, 29-17 in December, 29-9 in January and 42-17 in February
- The win over Averett was the 6th win in the month of November, tying a program record set back in 1980-81 which is the only other time an Eagle team won six games in November
- With the win over Bob Jones, the Eagles ensured at least a .500 or better record in December for a second straight season (4-3 last year) and the fourth time in the last five years

This is the program's 1,426th game as it holds an all-time record of 808-617

- Voted to finish second in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote) for the second time in the last three seasons
- Winthrop has 10 or more threes in 39 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 31-8 record in those 39 contests)
- Over the last four seasons Winthrop is 87-13 when leading at the half (144-24 since the start of the 2015-16 season/158-33 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 12 seasons the Eagles are 180-27 when leading at the half, 46-94 when trailing and 10-4 when tied In Big South contests since 2013-14, the Eagles are 117-16 when leading at the half, 34-39 when trailing and 7-3 when tied
- In the last 208 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 127 of them (61%)
- Over the last 12 seasons Winthrop is 171-65 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 53-13 when attempting 30 or more, 11-3 when attempting 40 or more and 1-1 when attempting 50-plus

During that same time span, Winthrop is 77-73 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts

- Have won 14 of the last 16 games attempting 30 or more free throws after having lost 4-of-5 prior
- In the last 12 seasons Winthrop is 78-11 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles have more wins than any other Big South Conference school (252), 34 more than the

TEAM STREAKS

- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 397 consecutive games
- Now have 12 straight seasons with 10 or more home wins
- Have been Top 3 scoring in the Big South for 10 straight seasons
- Have 20 or more free throw attempts in 13 straight games

HEAD COACH MARK PROSSER

- In his fourth season as head coach of the Eagles and 8th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Coached in his 100th game at the helm of the Eagles on Nov. 15 and earned his 100th career win in the same game
- Coached his 200th game and earned his 50th victory at Winthrop on Jan. 10 and earned an 81-71 road win
- Mark Prosser is coaching in his 231st game (203rd at NCAA D1 level)
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history

- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser is in his fourth season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2.. 2021.

On Nov. 15, Prosser earned his 100th career win as the Eagles defeated William & Mary 86-85 on a buzzer beater.

In 2023-24 the Eagles battled their way through injuries that led to 11 different starting lineups, finishing the season 17-15.

The team was one of the most aggressive teams in the nation and it showed with the second-most free throw attempts in program history (856). The Eagles also converted the second-most free throws made in a single-season at 601.

Winthrop finished first in the nation in free throw attempts per game at 26.8.

For the second time in three seasons the Eagles had nine non-conference victories, which included an 85-68 victory at Little Rock and 90-87 win at Coastal Carolina.

The Eagles battled through a injury-riddled 2022-23 and finished the season 15-17 overall and 10-8 in the Big South.

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games. He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in

three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/ turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.


