

### **EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM**

#### WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS PIEDMONT/NON-D1 OPPONENTS

- Winthrop and Piedmont meet for the 6th time and second time in three seasons
- Winthrop is 5-0 all-time against Piedmont
- Eagles have won 61 straight games over Non-D1 opponents and are 105-8 all-time
- In the last 18 meetings with non-D1 opponents the Eagles have scored 100 or more points in 12 of the meetings
- The most points Winthrop has ever scored vs. a Non-D1 opponent is 134 (program record) vs. Pfeiffer on Nov. 13, 2018
- The most points the Eagles have allowed against a Non-D1 opponent is 99 (Pfeiffer 11/13/18)
- Fewest points Winthrop has held a Non-D1 opponent is 34 vs. Limestone (1/2/08 in a 78-34 win)

#### AT HOME

- Closed out its 2023-24 home schedule with a 65-64 loss to Gardner-Webb
- Finished last season with an 11-5 record, 4-4 in non-conference and 7-1 in Big South action
- Eagles have now won 11 or more home games in 11 of the last 12 seasons
- Averaged 81.7 ppg while holding opponents to 66.9 ppg (Shot 49 percent from the floor while opponents shot 40 percent)
- The longest home win streak in program history is 24 from 2005-06/2007-08
- Hold an all-time record of 478-177 in home games and 428-165 at the Winthrop Coliseum
- Since 1998-99 the Eagles are 300-69 at home (.813 winning percentage)
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles are 140-34 at home (.805 winning percentage)
- As an NCAA D1 member the Eagles are 397-148 in home contests

#### **EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH**

- Finished with an 8-8 mark for a 4th place finish in the standings
- Now have 12 straight seasons with at least a .500 or better record in conference
- Started league play 4-0 for the first time since 2021-22 and the 4th time in the last five seasons
- It was the 8th 4-0 start in program history (in 2006-07 the Eagles went 14-0 in league play)
- The Eagles are 49-18 in conference play over the last four seasons and 64-21 over the last five
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 350-239 (.594)
- The 350 victories are the most by any Big South member

#### TEAM NEWS

- Return 4-of-5 starters from last year's team that was 17-15 overall
- All four returning starters were also the Top 4 in scoring from from 2023-24
- Two-Time All-Big South First Team selection Kelton Talford is the top returner as he led the team with 14.1 ppg and 5.8 rpg
- · K.J. Doucet was second on the team in scoring at 12.4 ppg and second on the team with 51 made threes
- Kasen Harrison was also in double-figures at 11.3 ppg and led the team with 3.8 apg (ranked 3rd in Big South)
- Nick Johnson averaged 10.4 ppg and led the team with 44 steals, while ranking 4th in the Big South at 1.4 per game
- · Also returning are Yoro Diallo and Noah Van Bibber as Diallo saw action in 28 games while Van Bibber played in 18 contests
- · Added six newcomers in the offseason, five of which are transfers and one true freshman
- The transfers include Ryan Jolly (Piedmont), Tommy Kamarad (Arkansas Tech), Tai Hamilton (William & Mary), Logan Duncomb (Xavier) and Bryce Baker (Old Dominion)
- Paul Jones III is the lone freshman on the team
- · Hold an all-time mark of 124-92 in the month of November, 135-148 in the month of December, 252-185 in January and 230-152 in February
- Last year the Eagles won five games in November, the most since the 2013-14 season (5)
- It was just the 8th time in program history the team won five games in November
- Since 2016-17 the Eagles are 17-4 in home games during the month of November, 29-17 in December, 26-9 in January and 42-17 in February
- This is the program's 1,408th game as it holds an all-time record of 797-612 The 2023-24 team set the NCAA D1 program record for free throws made (601) and free throws attempted (856) for a single-season
- The 18.8 free throws made per game were a program record, as were the 26.8 free throw attempts per game
- · Attempted 238 more free throws than opponents and made 601, which was nearly as many as opponents attempted (618)
- Winthrop led the nation in free throw attempts (26.8) and
- Eagles finished 9th in the nation in total free throw attempts, 16th in free throws made
- Voted to finish second in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll (1 first-place vote) for the second time in the last three seasons
- Winthrop has 10 or more threes in 36 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 28-8 record in those 36 contests)
- Over the last three seasons Winthrop is 78-12 when leading at the half (136-23 since the start of the 2015-16 season/150-32 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 11 seasons the Eagles are 171-26 when leading at the half, 44-90 when trailing and 10-4 when tied
- In Big South contests since 2013-14, the Eagles are 116-16 when leading at the half, 34-39 when trailing and 7-3 when tied
- In the last 197 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 121 of them (61%)
- Over the last 11 seasons Winthrop is 160-61 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 45-12 when attempting 30 or more, 7-2 when attempting 40 or more and 1-1 when attempting 50-plus
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 77-72 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- Have won seven of the last eight games attempting 30 or more free throws after having lost 4-of-5 prior
- In the last 11 seasons Winthrop is 74-11 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game
- Since 2012-13 the Eagles have more wins than any other Big South Conference school (239), 30 more than the next team (Gardner-Webb/UNC Asheville -209)

#### TEAM STREAKS

- Have hit at least one three-point basket in 381 consecutive games
- Have at least one block in 31 straight games
- Now have 12 straight seasons with 10 or more home wins
- Have been Top 3 scoring in the Big South for 10 straight seasons

### **EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM**

#### LOOKING BACK AT 2023-24

- · Season ended with a 69-56 loss to 5th-seeded Longwood, the eventual Big South Champion
- Bounced back from its first losing season since 2012-13 with a 17-15 mark

•

- Winthrop suffered its first losing season since 2012-13, finishing the 2022-23 campaign 15-17
- Battled through a number of injuries that started with the loss of four-year starter Michael Anumba in the preseason
- That led to 11 different starting lineups throughout the season
- Offensively the Eagles averaged 73.8 ppg, the lowest scoring average since 2014-15 and allowed the most points (74.3 ppg) since 2018-19
- When the Eagles scored at least 70 points, they held a record of 14-5
- Eagles dropped their opening game of the Big South Conference Tournament with a quarterfinals loss to Radford (78-69)
- Finished the season with 283 three-pointers, the sixth most made in a single-season in program history (averaged 8.84 per game)
- The 8.84 threes per game ranked 39th nationally and led the Big South Conference
- For the first time since 2016-17 the team had more turnovers than assists (366-447)
- Led the Big South in free throw percentage (.739), which was the third best in program history for a single-season

#### HEAD COACH MARK PROSSER

- In his fourth season as head coach of the Eagles and 8th season overall as a head coach
- He became the 7th head coach in program history and joined all previous head coaches in winning their first game coaching the Eagles
- Coached his 200th game and earned his 50th victory at Winthrop on Jan. 10 and earned an 81-71 road win
- Mark Prosser is coaching in his 206th game (178th at NCAA D1 level)
- Led the Eagles to 23 wins in 2021-22, the most by any first-year head coach in program history
- Prosser joined Steve Vacendak, Gregg Marshall and Randy Peele as the only coaches to start their Winthrop career 2-0
- Became 1-of-3 Winthrop coaches to win their first Big South Conference regular season game and to start 2-0 (Dan Kenney/Gregg Marshall) and just Prosser and Marshall began their Big South career 5-0
- First Winthrop coach to reach at least 11 league wins in first season at the helm (finished with 14)
- Guided the team to its first ever win over a PAC 12 opponent with an 82-74 win at Washington (11/27/21)
- Came to the Eagles after three years as head coach of Western Carolina
- In his second season with the Catamounts he and his staff put together the nation's second biggest turnaround in D1 men's basketball (12-win improvement)
- Spent six seasons at Winthrop as an Associate Head Coach (Assistant coach 1st year)
- Holds a career record of 97-117 (92-94 at the NCAA D1 level)
- Graduted from Marist and then became a student assistant three seasons before joining the staff at Wofford as an assistant coach in 2002-03
- After one season he became an assistant coach at Bucknell (2003-08)
- While at Bucknell, the Bison upset Kansas in the 2005 NCAA Tournament
- Returned to Wofford as an assistant coach in 2008 where he remained until taking the head coaching job at Brevard College in 2011-12=
- After one season he left Brevard to join the Winthrop coaching staff

# MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser enters his fourth season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2,, 2021.

In 2023-24 the Eagles battled their way through injuries that led to 11 different starting lineups, finishing the season 17-15.

The team was one of the most aggressive teams in the nation and it showed with the second-most free throw attempts in program history (856). The Eagles also converted the second-most free throws made in a single-season at 601.

Winthrop finished first in the nation in free throw attempts per game at 26.8.

For the second time in three seasons the Eagles had nine non-conference victories, which included an 85-68 victory at Little Rock and 90-87 win at Coastal Carolina.

The Eagles battled through a injury-riddled 2022-23 and finished the season 15-17 overall and 10-8 in the Big South.

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games. He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which

included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament.

Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/ turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlman, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.
