TIP-INS

- This marks the 50th meeting between the Eagles and Blue Hose
- Winthrop has won the last two meetings, including last year's trip to the Ross E. Templeton Center in an 81-77 victory
- Coming off a last second win over Radford, 76-75, as the Eagles improved to 4-3 in games decided by five or fewer points this year
- After dropping the league opener at Longwood, the Eagles have won six straight and sit atop of the league standings alone at 6-1
- Have won 14 of the last 16 regular season league contests
- Eagles are 6-0 to start January for the first time since the 2020-21 season when the team began the month 9-0
- Winthrop is 262-189 all-time in the month of January (4-4 in 2025)
- Eagles opened the season with 6-of-7 games on the road and the game at LIU wrapped up a stretch of 7-of-9 away from home
- Eagles are in their 48th season of basketball overall and 41st in the Big South Conference
- Coming off a season in which the Eagles fell in the Big South Conference Championship game
- It was the programs 19th Big South Conference Championship game appearance and 4th appearance in the previous six seasons
- Winthrop won 23 games in 2024-25, the 9th 20-win season in its D1 Era
- Eagles finished November at .500 and have now been .500 or better in 13 straight seasons
- On Nov. 17, 2024 the Eagles captured the program's 800th win all-time (834-631)
- The victory was also the 100th career win for head coach Mark Prosser
- In 2024-25, the Eagles earned 10 wins prior to league play for first time since 2015-16





EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

WINTHROP SERIES HISTORY VERSUS PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

- Eagles and Blue Hose meet for the 50th time
- Winthrop leads the all-time series 35-14 and have won 11-of-12 meetings
- The Blue Hose will be the 7th team the Eagles have faced 50 times in the history of the program
- Eagles won their last visit to the Ross E. Templeton Center, escaping with an 81-77 win
- In 49 meetings all-time the Eagles have scored 3,404 points (69.47 ppg) and the Blue Hose have scored 3,128 points (63.84 ppg)
- In the last seven meetings the team that led at the half has gone on to win the game
- Eagles currently have a seven-game winning streak at the Ross E. Templeton Center

ON THE ROAD IN BIG SOUTH

- Have won six of the last seven on the road dating back to last season after the 69-67 win at UNC Asheville
- Earned a 72-50 road win over USC Upstate, the fewest points allowed in a league game since holding Radford to 47 on Feb. 12, 2021 (Won 55-47)
- Dropped first road game in league play, falling 82-70 after shooting 32 percent
- Averaging 70.0 ppg and allowing 66.3 ppg while outrebounding opponents 42.0-36.7
- In three league road games the Eagles have earned 21 more free throw attempts
- Finished 4-4 on the road last season after starting 0-4
- In eight league road games last year, the Eagles are averaged 81.2 ppg and allowed 81.1 ppg
- Eagles earned 32 more free throw attempts and averaged 7.9 threes per game
- In the win over USC Upstate the Eagles scored 105 points, the fourth most points in a conference road game in program history
- It's the most points since winning 107-77 at USC Upstate on Dec. 13, 2020
- Eagles are 37-17 in the last 53 conference road games
- Under Prosser the Eagles are 20-17 in five seasons on the road
- Eagles have an all-time record of 156-151 in league road games

EAGLES ON THE ROAD

- Finished non-conference action 2-6 on the road, with five of the losses by seven or fewer points and two of them one possession games
- Picked up third road win of the season in a 71-50 victory over USC Upstate
- Eagles knocked down 12 threes in the win, the sixth time on the road this season with 10 or more
- Two road games in December came down to the final seconds with the Eagles on the positive side of a buzzer-beating overtime win at LIU
- The other saw the Eagles fall 94-92 at North Dakota after a three with .5 seconds left in the game
- Kody Clouet's tip-in in the buzzer at LIU gave the Eagles their second road win of the season
- Picked up first road win at Jackson State with a big second half that led to an 80-62 win
- Winthrop is averaging 76.5 ppg while shooting 41 percent from the floor and averaging 9.6 threes per game
- Opponents are averaging 78.4 ppg while shooting 45 percent averaging 8.7 threes per game
- The one point loss at #21 Arkansas was the first one point game in program history against a ranked opponent
- The loss at George Mason was the first game Winthrop hit 90 points in a non-conference road game since defeating Coastal Carolina 90-87 (12/2/23)
- In 2024-25 the Eagles were 5-8 on the road overall, 1-4 in non-conference action
- Picked up the lone road win at Queens on Dec. 3 in an 86-78 victory
- Four of the road losses last season were against Power 4 opponents in Virginia Tech (58-52), Louisville (76-61), Florida State (82-64) and Indiana (77-68)
- Have an all-time road mark of 274-390 and 222-337 at the NCAA D1 level
- Over the last eight seasons the Eagles are 71-67 on the road
- In 2024-25 - averaged 75.5 ppg while shooting 43 percent from the field and allowed 78.5 ppg and opponents shot 46 percent

EAGLES IN BIG SOUTH

- After dropping league opener at Longwood the Eagles have earned six consecutive wins including a wins over High Point and Radford that put the Eagles atop the league standings at 6-1
- Trailing by 10 points against Radford with 11:48 to play before rallying for a 76-75 victory thanks to a Kody Clouet three with two seconds to play
- It was Clouet's second game-winning shot with two or fewer seconds this season (first was tip-in at LIU at the buzzer)
- Since allowing 50 first half points to Gardner-Webb, the Eagles have held their opponents to 36 or fewer points and three times kept them under 30
- Over the five-game span the Eagle are allowing average of 28.4 points
- Eagles held the Panthers to nearly 20 points below their season average and held them to under 30 points in the first half
- Led by as much as 25 points in the first half, on their way to the first double-digit win over the Panthers since 2021
- Followed that up by holding UNC Asheville to 25 first half points
- Held opponents to under 30 points in the first half in three straight games (First time since the 2020-21 season when the Eagles did it in four straight)
- Sitting 6-1 in conference play for the second time under Prosser and the 7th time in program history
- Won 14 of the last 16 regular season league matchups
- Trailing by as much as nine points against Charleston Southern and rallied from 20 points down to defeat Gardner-Webb
- It was the largest deficit overcome by Winthrop since Feb. 24, 2009 when the Eagles trailed by 27 before a 57-52 win over Charleston Southern
- Opened league play with an 82-70 loss at Longwood, just the second loss in a league opener in the last 13 seasons
- Have 30 or more free throw attempts in five of the seven league games played
- Last season the Eagles finished 11-5 in the league and tied for second place with UNC Asheville last season
- Have been .500 or better the last 12 seasons in conference play (8-8 in 2023-24 was only year .500 - above .500 the other 11 seasons)
- Set a program record for points per game in league play (85.1) as the team scored 95 or more points six times (hitting the century mark 3 times)
- Reached 10 league wins for the 21st time in program history
- Have now earned at least 11 conference wins 15 times and the 8th when playing 16 or fewer conference games
- Last time the Eagles and Bucs faced off in Rock Hill, the Eagles captured a triple-overtime victory against Charleston Southern (102-97) on Jan. 15, 2025
- It was the first triple overtime game for the Eagles since Jan. 13, 2024 in a 92-88 win over Radford
- Eagles now have an all-time overtime record of 44-32 and are a perfect 4-0 in triple overtime games
- Led the league last season in steals per game at 7.94 and offensive rebounds (12.38)
- It was the first time since 2020-21 the Eagles led the conference in steals and only third time in program history
- Have 12 straight seasons with at least a .500 or better record in conference
- The Eagles are 65-24 in conference play over the last six seasons and 81-28 over the last seven
- Eagles played their 600th regular season conference game on Feb. 8 at USC Upstate
- Hold an all-time regular season league record mark of 367-246 (.598)
- The 367 victories are the most by any Big South member

TEAM NEWS

- This is the program's 1,466th game as Winthrop holds an all-time record of 834-631
- On a season-best six-game winning streak, the second time under Prosser with a win streak of six or better (best is 10 in 2021-22)
- Have back-to-back one possession wins after Clouet's three with two seconds left gave the Eagles a 76-75 win over Radford
- It was the first win all season for the Eagles when being outrebounded and made fewer free throws than their opponent
- Against the Highlanders, Kareem Rozier led the Eagles with 20 points as he was an efficient 7-of-8 from the floor and 6-of-7 from three
- Winthrop has now had a 20-point scorer in seven straight games
- Grinded out a win at UNC Asheville despite top two scorers on the team a combined 6-for-18 shooting and the absence of one of its top scorers in Daylen Berry (11.1 ppg)
- Winthrop had as big of a lead as 12 at Asheville and now has held a double-digit lead in four straight games
- Ended a five-game losing streak to High Point with a 17-point victory (92-75) and have now won four straight games overall
- At one stretch in the game the Eagles hit 11 consecutive field goals
- Eagles won their third straight game after a 71-50 road win over USC Upstate
- Winthrop began the game 0-for-6 from the field and didn't score for the first four minutes, but jumped out to a 20-5 lead in a five-minute span and cruised from there
- In the win over Radford, the Eagles connected on 12 threes and now have 14 games with 10 or more threes (record is 22 set by 2018-19 squad)
- The 14 games are tied for the third most in a single-season in the history of the program
- Earned an 81-77 comeback win over Charleston Southern for a 5th straight home win and to improve to 2-0 in league play at home
- Prior to that the Eagles mounted the largest comeback in 18 seasons, overcoming a 20 point deficit to defeat Gardner-Webb
- It was the largest comeback during the Mark Prosser Era
- Eagles are averaging 9.9 threes per game, trying to become just the second team in program history to average 10 or more threes in a single-season
- Only one other team in program history averaged 10 or more threes in a single-season, which was the 2018-19 team which led the nation at 12.4 In the win over High Point the Eagles hit 10 threes, which is the 13th game on the season with 10 or more
- Recently reached 200 threes on the season, becoming the 23rd team in program history to reach that mark
- The 218 threes on the season are the 16th most in a single-season in program history

EAGLE EYE VIEW OF THE TEAM

- Suffered first double-digit loss of the season in an 87-57 loss at #15 Texas Tech (only other double-figure loss was 82-70 at Longwood)
- The 57 points were a season-low and just the second time the Eagles have scored under 73 points
- Eagles wrapped-up non-conference action with a winning record for a third straight season
- Have now posted a .500 or better record in non-conference play in 13 of the last 14 seasons
- Posted the 5th 100-point game of the season with a 107-41 victory over Clinton College
- The 66-point margin of victory was the most under head coach Mark Prosser
- It was also the second-largest margin of victory in program history
- Winthrop led by as much as 70 in the game, the largest lead under Prosser (previous best was 54)
- On Dec. 18 the Eagles fell 90-88 as North Dakota hit a game-winning three with .5 seconds to play
- Eagles led by as much as 11 in the game, the first non-conference loss when holding a double-digit lead since Nov. 11, 2023 vs. Drexel at home
- Suffered first home loss of the season vs. Coastal Carolina on Dec. 6 (88-84) in the final seconds
- Both contests during the week of Dec. 1-7, both games came down to the wire as the week started off with a 94-92 overtime win at LIU at the buzzer
- This was the first buzzer beater since Bryce Baker drilled a three as time expired to defeat William & Mary on Nov. 15, 2024
- Eagles finished the month of November with a .500 record to stretch their streak to 13 straight season with a .500 or better mark in the month of November
- Earned first road win of the year, as the Eagles knocked down eight second half threes to earn an 80-62 win at Jackson State
- Eagles had 13 threes in the loss at Nebraska, the second game with 13 or more vs. a Power 4 opponent this season
- The win was on the heels of a one point loss at #21 Arkansas (84-83), the first one-point game with a Top 25 or Power 4 opponent in program history
- It was the sixth game all-time against a Power 4 opponent that was a one possession (3pts or less) game, win or lose
- The 83 points were the most by a Winthrop team against a nationally-ranked opponent
- The Eagles knocked down a season-high 15 threes in the game, the most versus a Power 4 opponent since the team had 16 on Nov. 22, 2021 in a 92-86 loss at Washington State
- The 15 threes were tied for the most against a Top 25 opponent
- On Nov. 15, the Eagles earned a 105-69 victory over Mercer, the largest margin of victory over a non-conference opponent since defeating Holy Cross 89-51 on Nov. 17, 2023 (+38)
- The 105 points are the second-most against an NCAA D1 non-conference opponent (106 vs. Central Connecticut State on Jan. 18, 1993 is the most)
- Winthrop led by as much as 43 in the win over Mercer, the largest lead vs. a D1 opponent under Mark Prosser
- It was the largest lead held by an Eagle team vs. a D1 opponent since they led Liberty by 43 on Feb. 28, 2006
- That season the Eagles defeated Birmingham-Southern for the largest margin of victory over a D1 opponent (+41) and led by as much as 48 in the game
- After posting 101 points against S.C. State, the Eagles now have 13 games of 100 or more points under Prosser, whose Eagles set a program record with six games of 100 or more in 2024-25
- Eagles had just 14 (6&8) turnovers in back-to-back games (at George Mason/at Coastal Carolina), the lowest in back-to-back games since the 2023-24 team has 14 in back-to-back in a win over Elon (7) and loss at Georgia (7)
- In the loss to the George Mason, the Eagles finished with zero second chance points (first time since 11/20/21 at Vanderbilt)
- Eagles attempted 29 free throws in the game, but George Mason went to the line 43 times
- It's the most free throw attempts against the Eagles since Mar. 7, 2025 in the opening round of the Big South Tournament quarterfinal vs. Longwood (42)
- It's the most against a non-conference opponent since Florida State had 42 on Dec. 22, 2023 in a 67-61 victory over the Eagles
- Opened up the season with an 81-74 win over Queens at the Field of 68 Opening Day Marathon
- The Eagles picked up right where they've left off the last two seasons at the free throw line, earning 60 free throw attempts in the first two games
- Led the nation in free throw attempts per game (28.5) last year and were 4th in makes per game (19.1)
- Set a program record for free throws attempted (970) and free throws made (648) in a single-season
- This year the Eagles are averaging 18.5 free throws made per game and averaging 25.5 free throw attempts per game
- The 18.5 per game are on pace for the 3rd best average in a single-season
- Hold an all-time mark of 134-99 in the month of November, 143-153 in the month of December, 262-189 in January, 236-153 in February and 56-36 in March
- Mark Prosser coached his 100th game as head coach of the Eagles on Nov. 15 and captured his 100th career win the same day
- The win also marked the 800th in program history
- The 100th win for Prosser came on a three-pointer at the buzzer-beater
- It was the first buzzer beater win for the Eagles since Keon Johnson's jumper as time expired in an 86-84 victory at Radford on Jan. 13, 2016
- Voted to finish fifth in the Big South Conference Preseason Poll, one vote behind Radford (4th) and Longwood (3rd)
- Winthrop has 10 or more threes in 60 games in the Prosser Era (Hold a 47-13 record in those 60 contests and 15-5 when hitting 13 or more)
- Over the last five seasons Winthrop is 109-17 when leading at the half (163-28 since the start of the 2015-16 season/177-37 since the 2014-15 season)
- In the last 14 seasons the Eagles are 202-31 when leading at the half, 49-104 when trailing and 11-4 when tied
- In the last 233 victories, the Eagles have won by double-figures in 143 of them (62%)
- Over the last 14 seasons Winthrop is 189-76 when attempting 20 or more free throws, 63-17 when attempting 30 or more, 12-4 when attempting 40 or more and 1-1 when attempting 50-plus
- During that same time span, Winthrop is 83-76 when it has less than 20 free throw attempts
- Have won 24 of the last 30 games attempting 30 or more free throws after having lost 4-of-5 prior
- In the last 14 seasons Winthrop is 84-15 when making 10 or more threes and attempting 20 or more free throws in same game

MARK PROSSER

Mark Prosser is in his fifth season at the helm of the men's basketball program.

Prosser became the 7th head coach in Winthrop men's basketball history when he was introduced Apr. 2., 2021.

On Nov. 15, Prosser earned his 100th career win as the Eagles defeated William & Mary 86-85 on a buzzer beater.

Last season he guided the Eagles to their second 23-win season during his tenure. The team also advanced to the Big South Championship game before falling to top-seeded High Point. It was the 2nd championship appearance under Prosser.

The 2024-25 team broke the program record for points per game (84.7), total points (2,879), free throws made (648) and free throws attempted (970). Winthrop also led all of NCAA D1 in free throws made and attempted per game.

In 2023-24 the Eagles battled their way through injuries that led to 11 different starting lineups, finishing the season 17-15.

The team was one of the most aggressive teams in the nation and it showed with the second-most free throw attempts in program history (856). The Eagles also converted the second-most free throws made in a single-season at 601.

Winthrop finished first in the nation in free throw attempts per game at 26.8.

For the second time in three seasons the Eagles had nine non-conference victories, which included an 85-68 victory at Little Rock and 90-87 win at Coastal Carolina.

The Eagles battled through a injury-riddled 2022-23 and finished the season 15-17 overall and 10-8 in the Big South.

In his first season with the Eagles he guided them to the Big South Conference Championship game and a 23-win season.

The 23 wins were the most by any coach in program history in their first season. It was the third time a first-year head coach won 20 or more games.

He joined Gregg Marshall as the only coaches in program history to begin conference play 5-0 in their first season.

On Nov. 27, 2021 he led the Eagles to the program's first ever win over a PAC-12 opponent with an 82-74 victory at Washington.

The Eagles posted a 13-0 home record, just the third time in program history a team finished with a perfect record at home.

Prosser has spent the previous three seasons as the head coach of the Western Carolina men's basketball program and is no stranger to Winthrop. In April of 2012, Prosser was hired as an assistant coach under Pat Kelsey and then served as Associate Head Coach from August of 2013 until his departure to Western Carolina in the spring of 2018.

Before departing for Western Carolina, Prosser played a role in helping bring the Winthrop men's basketball program back to the top of the Big South Conference, which was achieved when the Eagles captured the 2017 Big South Conference Championship and returned to the NCAA Tournament.

"My family and I could not be more excited to come home to Winthrop University and the Rock Hill community," said Prosser. "We'd like to thank Dr. Halpin, Dr. Hynd, the Board of Trustees and the entire Winthrop community for entrusting us with one of the most prestigious college basketball programs in the country."

In just his second season at the helm of the Catamounts program, Prosser led the team to a 12-win improvement to finish the season at 19-12. It was the second-most improved mark across NCAA Division I men's basketball. That season the team reached the Southern Conference semifinals before falling to eventual champion ETSU. That season Prosser's achievement was recognized by College Insider as he was

honored as the Skip Prosser 'Man of the Year' award, which is named after his father.

Winthrop has been one of the top three-point shooting teams in the Big South Conference and nationally over the last 5-6 years and Prosser's teams in three seasons averaged 9.15 threes per game, which included a program record for a single-season with 302 in 2019-20. In 2018-19 the team set the program record for threes in a single-season, which now sits as the second-most.

Prosser began his coaching career as an assistant coach with Wofford College in Mike Young's first season (2002-03). During that season the Terriers posted a 14-15 mark, which included a 79-77 victory at Virginia Tech. In the Southern Conference, Wofford posted an 8-8 record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the conference tournament. Following his year at Wofford, Prosser headed to Bucknell as an assistant from 2003-08 under Pat Flannery.

It was at Bucknell that Prosser experienced the most post-season success as the Bison scored two NCAA Tournament upset victories during his tenure. In 2005, the 14th-seeded Bison upset No. 3 Kansas in the first round, earning the award for "Best Upset" at the 2005 ESPY Awards, and finished the year ranked 25th overall nationally with a 23-10 record. The following season, No. 9 seed Bucknell defeated No. 8 Arkansas in March Madness.

In 2005-06, the Bison went undefeated in Patriot League play, the first team to do so in conference history. The team was ranked in the top 25 for the first time in school history and featured Patriot League Player of the Year Charles Lee. For the NCAA Tournament, the Bison were seeded 9th and defeated Arkansas in the first round. In the second round they were defeated by Memphis to end the season at 27-5, the best record in school history.

While at Bucknell, Prosser signed 2008 Patriot League All-Freshman team selection Todd O'Brien and was involved in the player development of Charles Lee, who went on to sign a professional contract with the NBA's San Antonio Spurs. Lee was a three-time All-Patriot League selection and the 2006 Patriot League Player of the Year.

In the summer of 2008, Prosser returned to the sidelines at Southern Conference-member Wofford. During his first season back in Spartanburg in 2008, the Terriers set a school record with 12SoCon wins. In addition, the team posted its first winning overall record since moving to the NCAA Division I level. The following year, Prosser helped Wofford reach a school-record 26 wins along with the Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

All told, with Prosser on the bench in Spartanburg, the Terriers posted a 63-36 (.636) overall record, highlighted by back-to-back SoCon regular season and tournament championships, and consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. He helped Wofford to a then school-record 26 victories in 2009-10 with a second 20-win season in 2010-11 with a squad that led the SoCon in assists and was also first in assist/turnover margin. Wofford also was eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage and 12th in overall field goal percentage.

Prosser was instrumental in the development of three-time first-team All-SoCon selection Noah Dahlgren, a post player who scored more than 2,000 career points and was twice dubbed SoCon Tournament MVP.

A native of Wheeling, W.Va., Prosser played collegiately at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., before a knee injury ended his career prematurely. He began his coaching career as a student assistant coach at Marist until his graduation in 2002, helping the Red Foxes to a share of the Metro-Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) regular season title in 2001-02.

Prosser and his wife Emily are the parents of two -- a daughter, Ava Grayce and a son, Declan.
